

MATTHEW A. YEARSLEY and **RALPH HARMAN** being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by ICG Tygart Valley, LLC well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 12th day of June, 2025 and that the well was plugged in the following manner:

	Cleaned a 3 1/4" through existing 4 1/2" casing from the surface to 4505'. Cemented the bottom hole from 4505' to 1260' with 200 sacks of Expandable Cement with a Gas Blocker additive. Removed 1280' of 4 1/2" casing from the surface to 1280'. Left 3260' of 4 1/2" casing was left in the hole from 1280' to 4540'. Cleaned a 7 7/8" hole from the surface to the top of the bottom hole plug at 1280'. Due to extreme cement bonding, a 30' window was section milled from 182' to 812' through the Lower Kittanning Coal Seam (794.0'-800.0'). Left 919' of 8 5/8" casing in the hole from the surface to 782' and 812' and 949' of 8 5/8" casing left in the hole. Due to the extreme cement bonding on the 8 5/8" casing, no additional cuts, rips or perforations were required by the Leer Mine 101C petition. Left 19.0' of 13 3/8" casing in the hole from the surface to 19'. 13 3/8" casing depth was taken from original well record. Cemented the hole from 960' to the surface as follows: From 1280' to 594' with 225 sacks of Thixotropic Cement with Green Dye and from 594' to the surface with 140 sacks of Expandable Cement.
