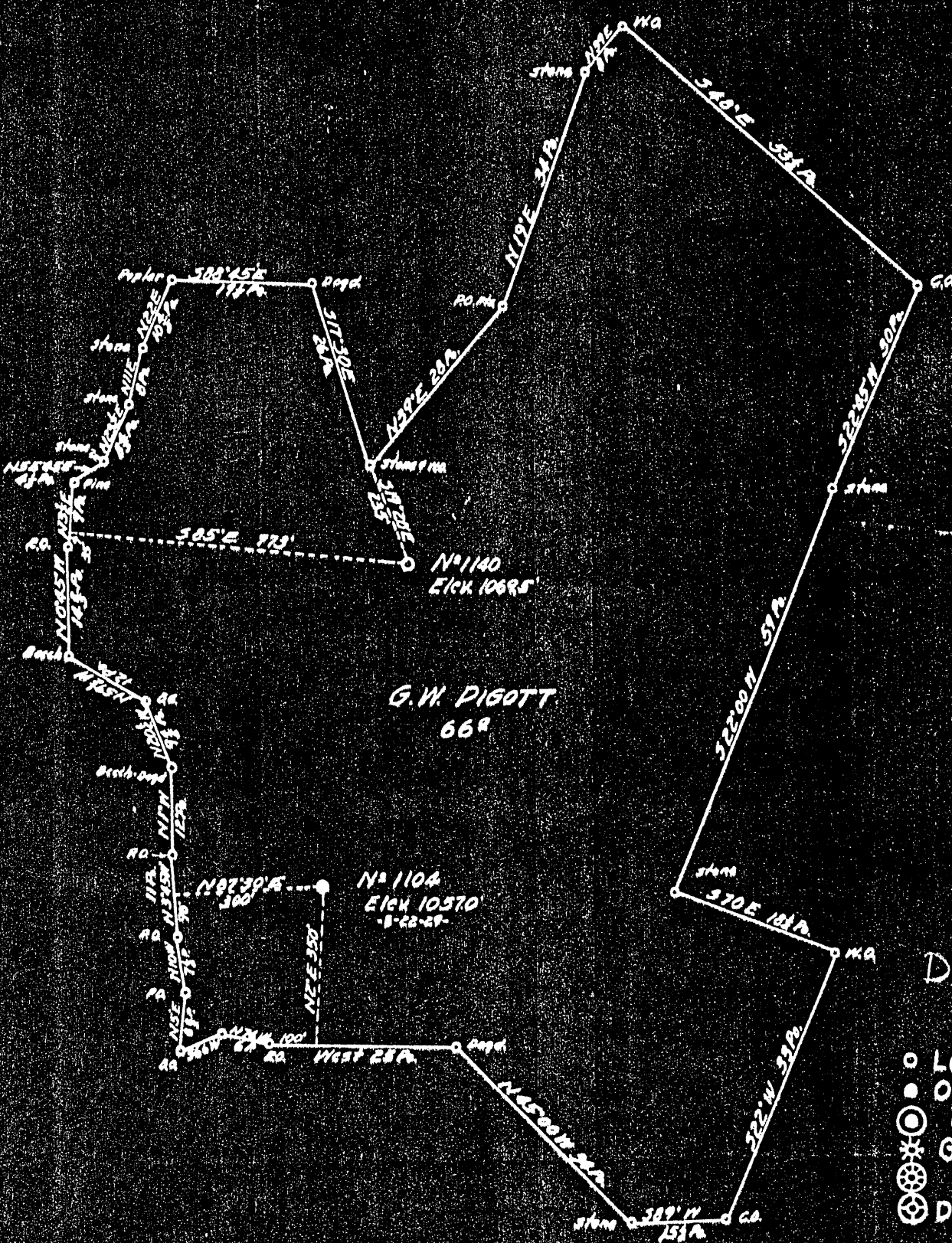


Plat of proposed location No 1140 of the

 CENTRAL District DORRIDGE County



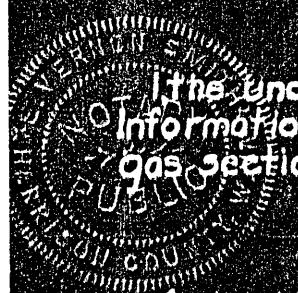

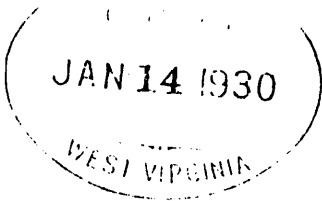
