10" casing, 110' (pulled); 8", 874' (pulled); 6", 1605'; 4" tubing, 1829'.

1 1/2" tubing run inside 4" tubing, 1833'. 1 1/2" packer set at 1575'.

Shot June 9, 1930, with 30 cts., at 1811-1816'.

Test before cleaning out, 3/10 W. 1/2", 5,190 cu. ft.

Test before shot, 25/10 W. 1/2", 14,880 cu. ft.

Test after shot (24 hrs.) 28/10 W. 1", 62,160 cu. ft.

Rock, 80 lbs. Line pressure, 100 to 125 lbs.

Cleaned and shot June 9, 1930. No results. Rock pressure came up to 80 lbs. Well being pulled.

Abandoned August 1930.
