Enclosed are copies of the entire files for wells drilled under the above captioned permit numbers.

Violation notices were posted on these five (5) wells on March 4, 1978, giving Mr. Ramsey until March 16, 1978 to abate the violations. Orders for Notices to Abate Violations (NY-30's) were sent to Mr. Ramsey on March 21, 1978, certified mail-return receipt requested.

According to K. Earl Goodnight, District Inspector, these wells have been abandoned for weeks consecutive months and are presumed to be abandoned and must be plugged - 22-1-7.

We are therefore, requesting that you initiate immediate action for bond forfeiture so that we can have these abandoned wells properly plugged.
