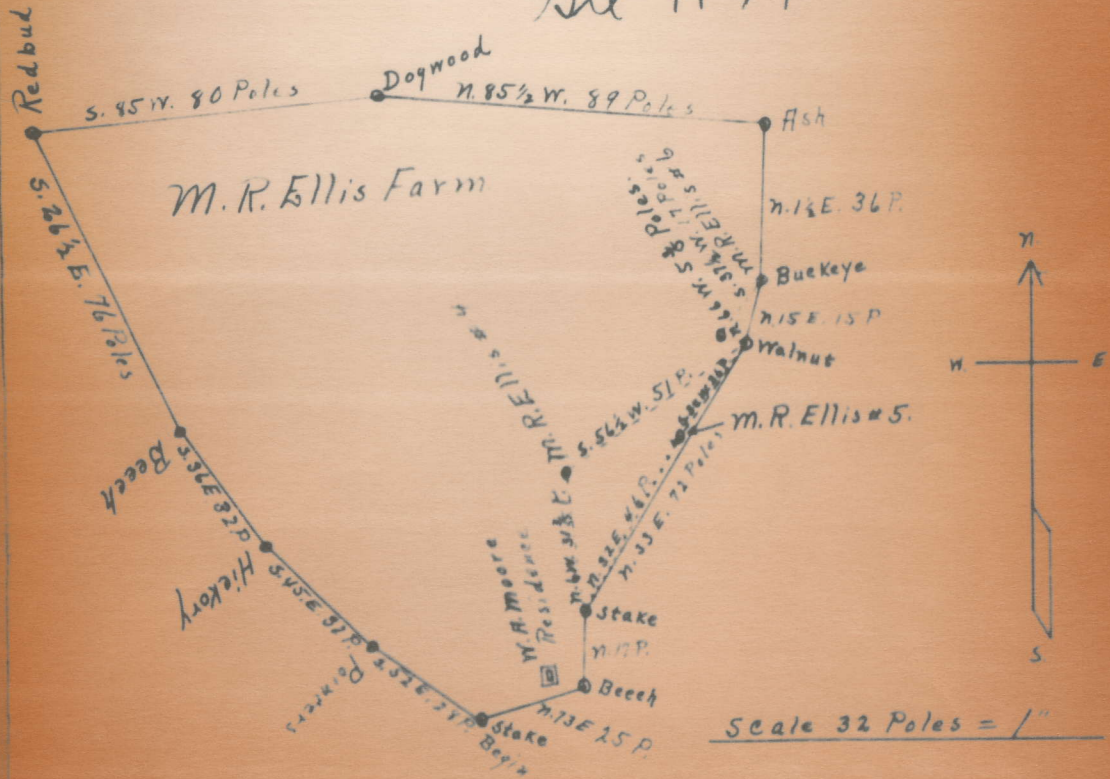

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Ellis Rittenhouse O & G Co. well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 22nd day of July, 1931, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged:

Filled it up to 1586 feet with red mud, stone and cement, drove two seasoned wood plugs and it showed no sign of shut off, we filled up 50 feet with red mud and rock and at 1536 drove a lead plug and completely sealed the hole up. Gave it about four days test it showed a complete shut off, then we shot off the pipe at 1536 feet, and pulled it out and filled the hole with red clay and stone.
