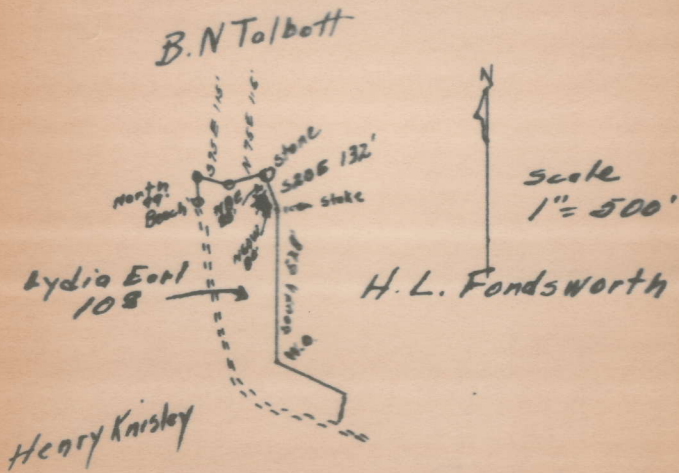
**WELL LOCATION PLAT**

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Litton Drilling Co., well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 30 day of April, 1934, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which said well was plugged: Filled with clay from 1620 to 1525, 1525 - 1522 wood plug, 1522 to 1512 cement  
Removed 6 5/8" casing and continued to fill with clay to 1415.  
1415 to 1405 cement  
Permanent bridge at 1259 and filled with clay to 1117, 1117 to 1107 cement.  
Permanent bridge at 972 and filled with clay to 801, 801 to 791 cement  
Permanent bridge at 540 and filled with clay to 485, 485 to 475 cement  
Filled to 390, Tried to pull 8 1/4" casing and parted it at 315.  
~~Placed plug in top of casing left in well and cemented to 300.~~  
Placed plug in top of casing left in well and cemented to 300.  
Filled to 276 and removed 10" casing.  
Continued to fill to surface.
