being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by HOPE CONSTRUCTION & REFINING CO., well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 24th day of February, 1936, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged: Filled with clay from total depth at 2301 up to 2262 ft. which is above Berea sand, set cement plug at 2262, installed permanent bridge at 2035 ft. and filled with clay to 1936 ft. drove 5" lead plug at 1936 ft. installed permanent bridge at 1690 and filled with clay to 1215 ft. and set cement plug, bridged at 998 ft. and drove 8" wood plug, and cement plug at 998, filled to surface.
Manner in which coal was plugged: with clay and sand.

Description of monument: concrete monument erected 5 ft. in length buried 2 1/2 ft. below surface, inscribed H O - H O well #216.
