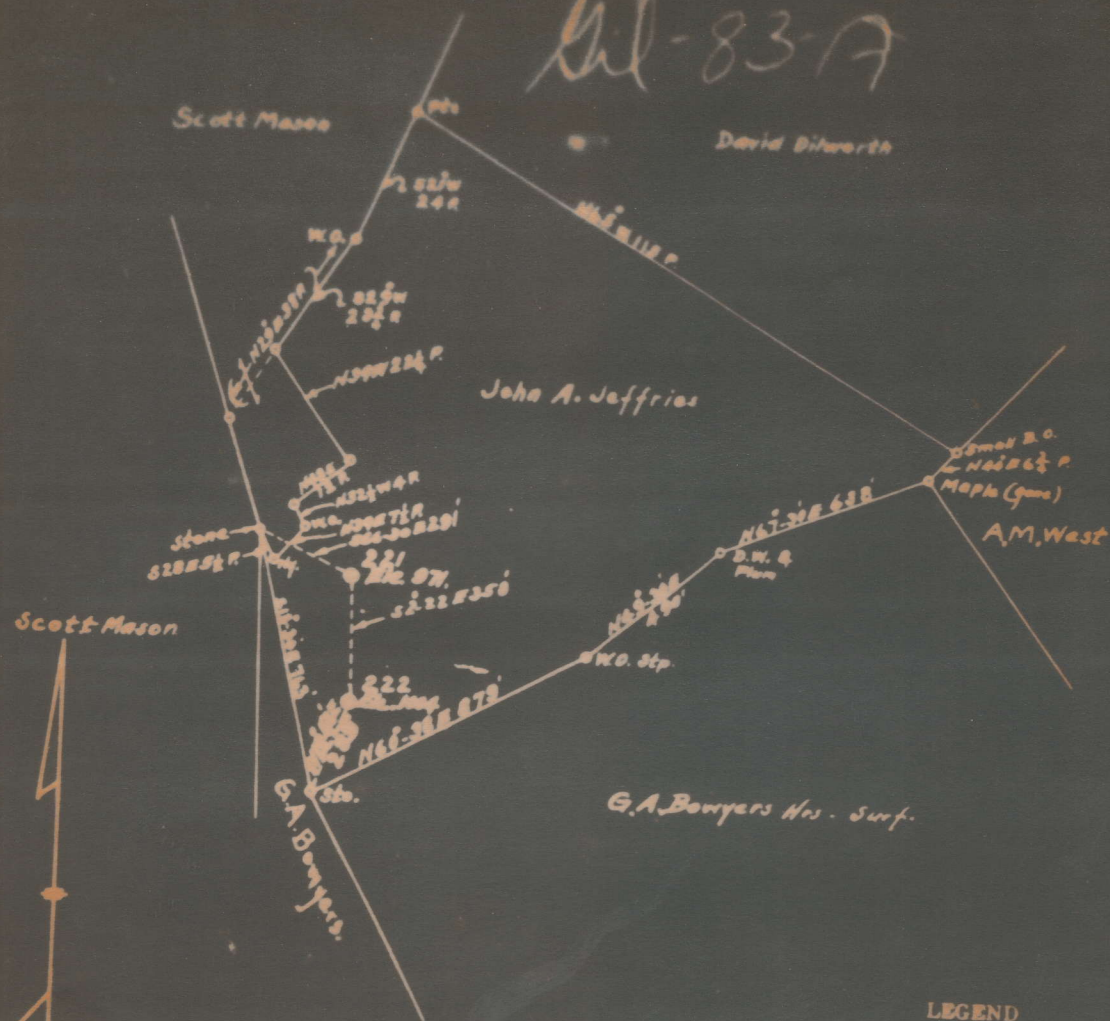

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by HOPE CONSTRUCTION & REFINING COMPANY

and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the

22nd day of APRIL, 1935, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which said well was plugged: Filled with clay from 2273' to 2255' and set cement plug at 2255'. Installed permanent bridge at 1945' and drove sand plug filled up solid with clay to 1875' and drove lead coal plug, installed cement bridge at 1705' and filled with clay to 1485'. Installed bridge at 1405' and drove sand plug Clay to 875' and drove 8" lead plug, filled up solid to 875' and set cement plug at 875'. Filled up solid to the surface with clay and stone.

Description of monument: concrete monument erected over the hole 3' in diameter 24' underground and 24' above ground.
