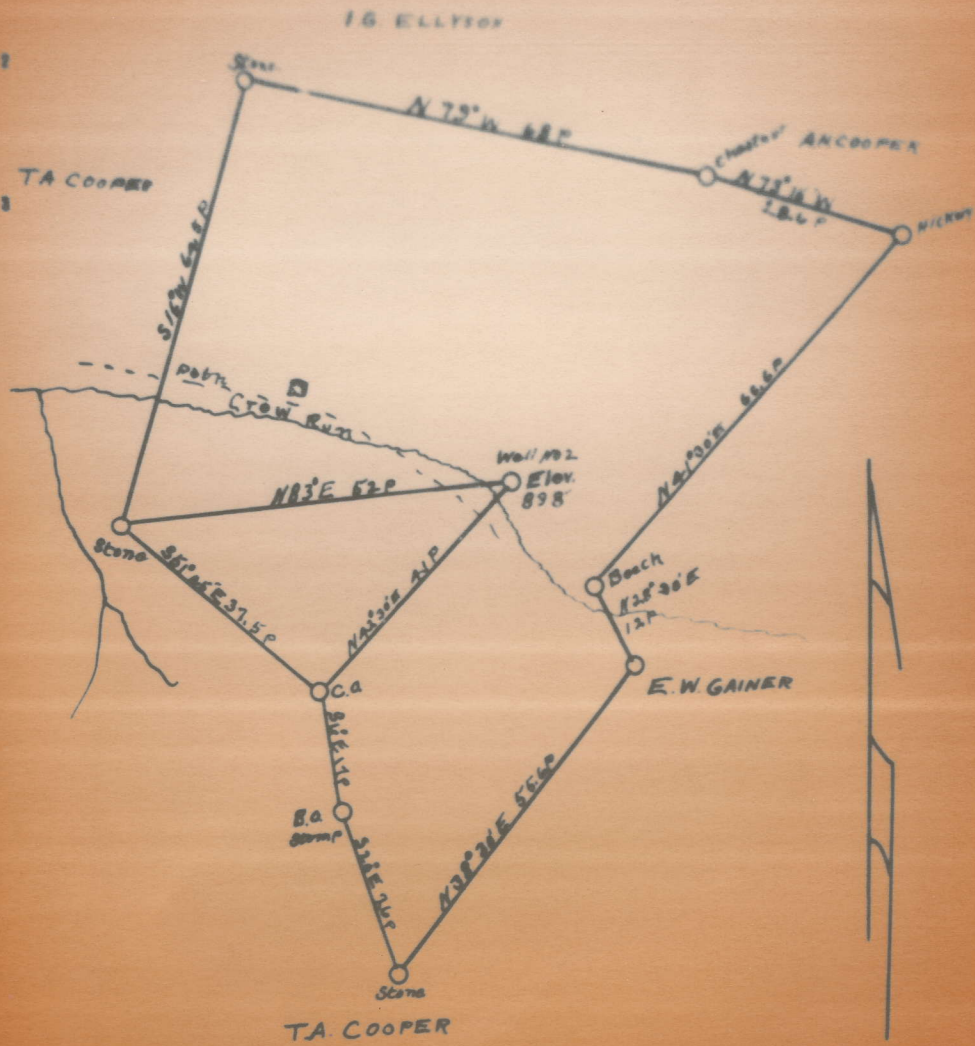

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging
and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Snyder Brothers and Zimm well operators
and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the
12th day of September, 19 36, and that the well was plugged and filled in
the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged: filled with red clay from 1618' to 1655' -20'
above Big Injun Sand, drove wood plug 1688' to 1685' cemented 1680' to
1675' continued to fill with red clay from 1645' to 1645', drove wood plug from
1645' to 1642', lifted casing to 950', filled with red clay from 1642' to
935' -20' above salt sand, drove wood plug 985' to 982', cemented 980' to
972' casing hole above salt sand, pulled balance of casing and filled with
red clay to 693' -20' above Big Dunkard sand, drove wood plug 693' to 690'
cemented from 690' to 680' casing hole completely continued to fill with
red clay to surface
