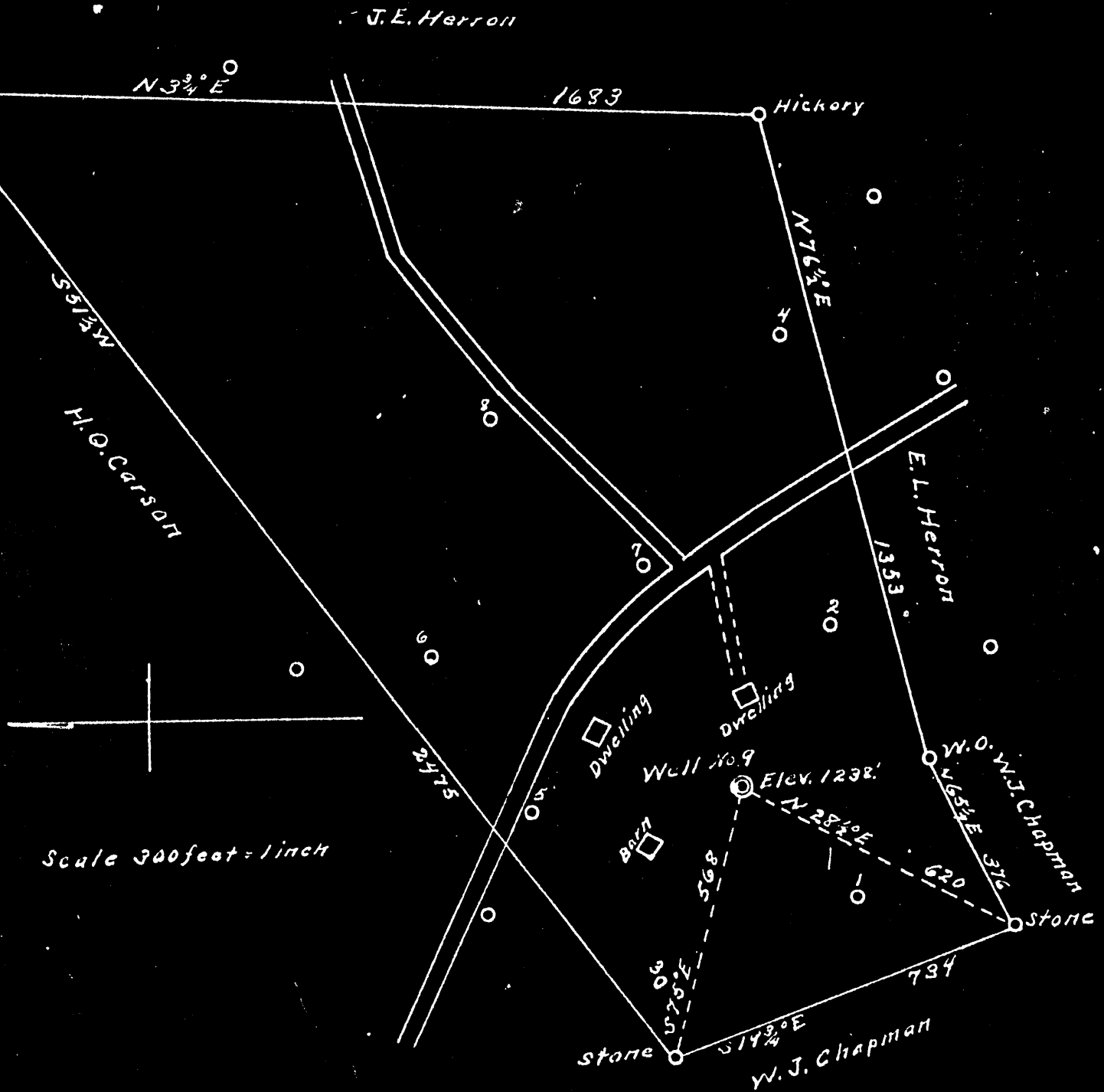




Plat of the Proposed Location of Well No. 9 of the

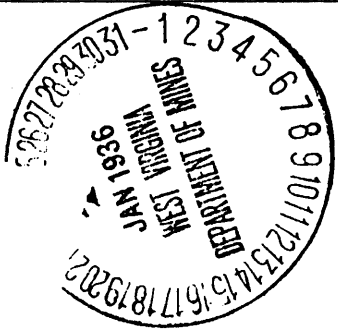
