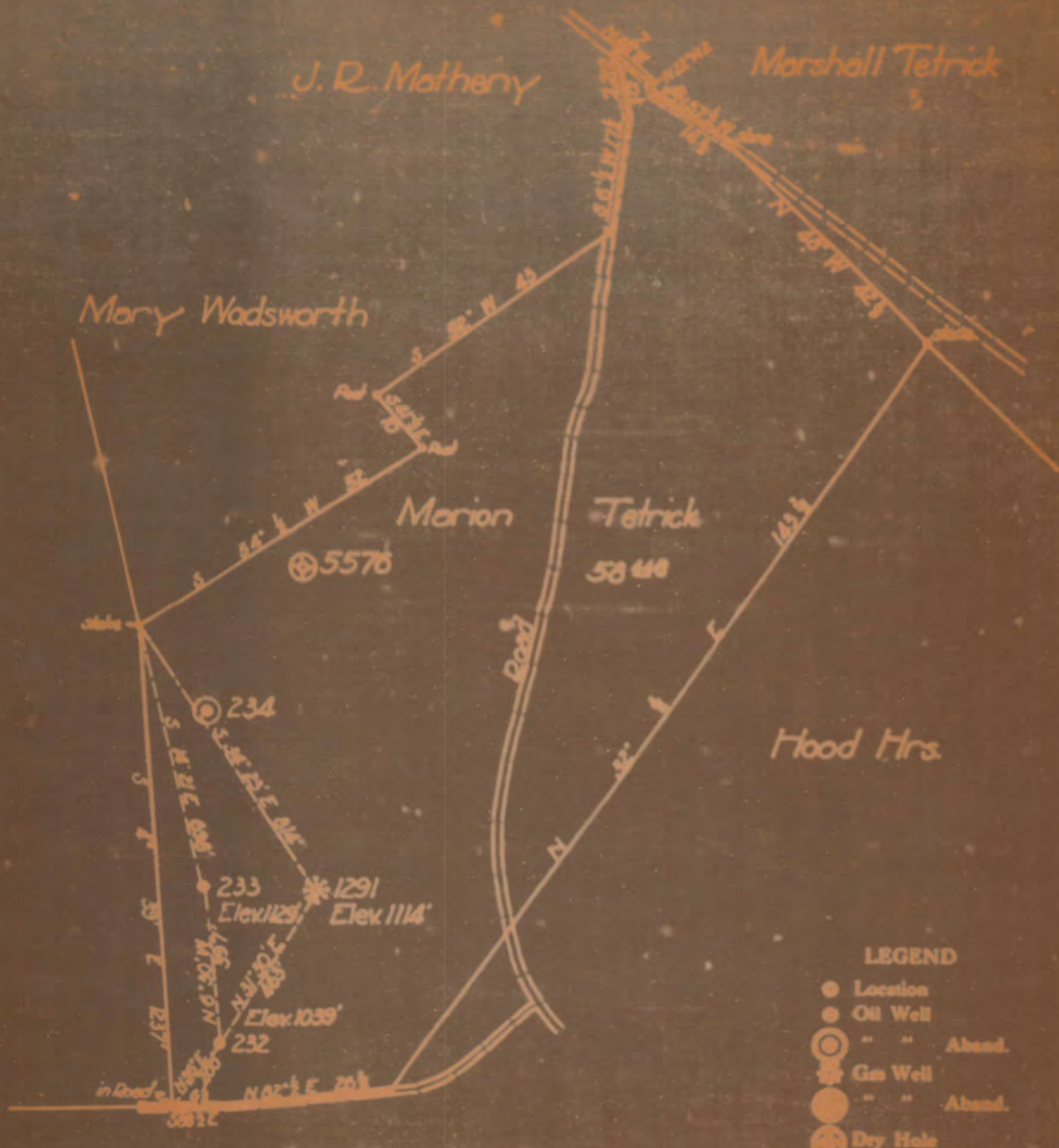

I, John H. ... being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are operators of the work of plugging and filling of gas wells and were employed by Consolidated Coal Company well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 6th day of January 1935 and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Me in which sand was plugged: Wood plug was driven and intervals filled with cement above Gordon to 232'-above fifty foot clay as follows: Big Injun sand to 2100' - above surface--10' and left in to 1638'-above Salt Sand to 2000' - above surface--10' and left in and hole open from 550 to well to surface.

Me in which coal was plugged: Filled with cement to surface.

Depth of monument:
 1. Top of 10" casing extends above ground in perforated
 2. Cemented in three feet under surface ground.
