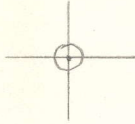

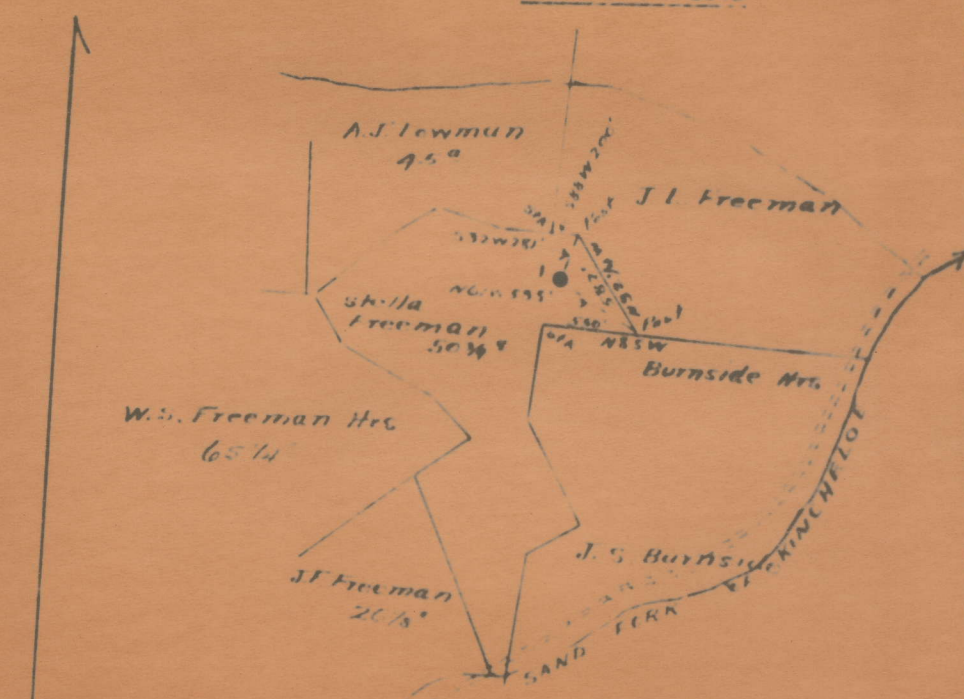

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by *South Penn Oil Company*, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the *15th* day of *September*, 1930, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which said well was plugged: Filled with stone and sediment from total depth to 2740'. Put in 6 3/8 x 3' Wood Plug and filled with cement and stone to 2730 ft. Bridged hole at 2325 ft. and filled with stone and clay to 2180'. Put in 2nd. 6 3/8 x 3' Wood Plug and filled with cement and stone to 2165'. Pulled 6 3/8 casing as drove 8 1/2' Wood Plug at 2165 and filled with stone and clay to 2130. Pulled 8 1/2' casing. Bridged hole at 755' and filled to 740'. Ran packer on 2" tubing with 10' of anchor below packer with perforation in top of anchor and filled with cement to depth of 670' and filled with stone to top of surface.
