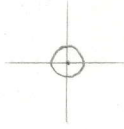

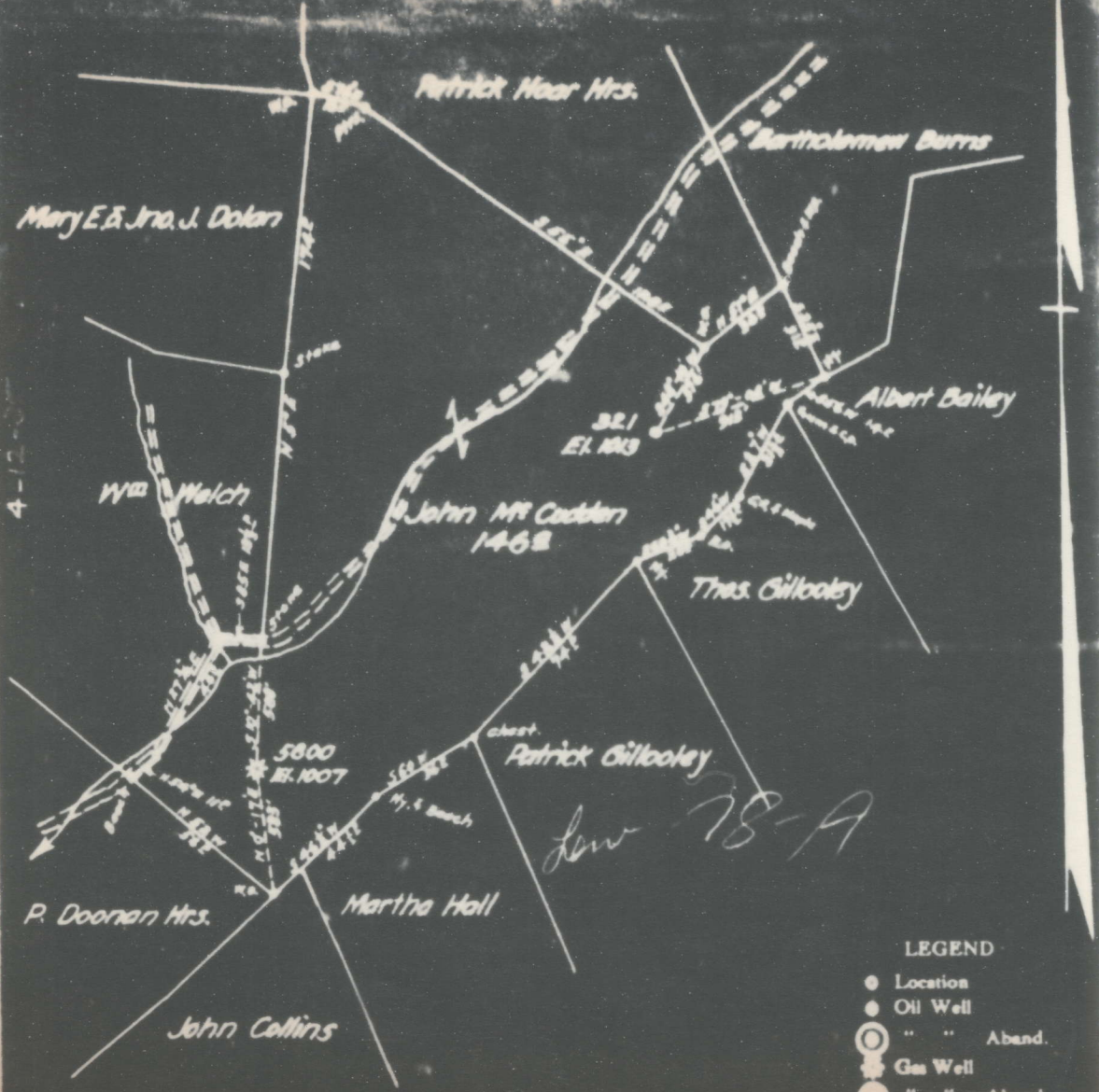

Leroy Cassidy and William Cassidy
being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by themselves, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 3rd day of JUNE, 1935, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which said well was plugged: Fill with red clay from 2043' to 2745'; drive plug from 2745' to 2742'; cement from 2742' to 2732'; fill with red clay from 2732' to 2548'; pull 5-1/16" casing; fill with clay from 2548' to 2540'; drive wood plug from 2540' to 2547'; cement from 2547' to 2527'; fill with clay from 2527' to 2520'; drive wood plug from 2520' to 2517'; cement from 2517' to 2507'; fill with clay from 2507' to 2447'; set permanent bridge at 2445'; fill with clay from 2445' to 1917'; cement from 1917' to 1917'; drive wood plug from 1917' to 1897'; pull 6-5/8" casing; fill with red clay from 1897' to 1871'; cement from 1871' to 1868'; cement from 1868' to 1858'; clay from 1858' to 1835'; drive wood plug from 1835' to 1832'; cement from 1832' to 1828'; fill with clay from 1828' to 1597'; cement from 1597' to 1597'; drive wood plug from 1597' to 1597'; set permanent bridge at 1255'; fill with red clay from 1255' to 1701'; drive wood plug from 1175' to 1167'; cement from 1167' to 1157'; fill with red clay from 1157' to 1045'; drive wood plug from 1045' to 1042'; cement from 1042' to 1037'; fill with red clay from 1037' to 890'; pull 4" casing; fill with red clay from 890' to 880'; drive wood plug from 880' to 877'; cement from 877' to 867'; fill with red clay from 867' to 770'; drive wood plug from 770' to 767'; cement from 767' to 757'; fill with clay from 757' to 737'; pull 1 1/2" casing; set permanent bridge at 175'; fill with clay to surface and erect a marker such as is described in Rule 14, 1931 regulations.

and that the work of plugging and filling said well was completed on the 14 day of June
