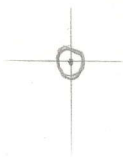

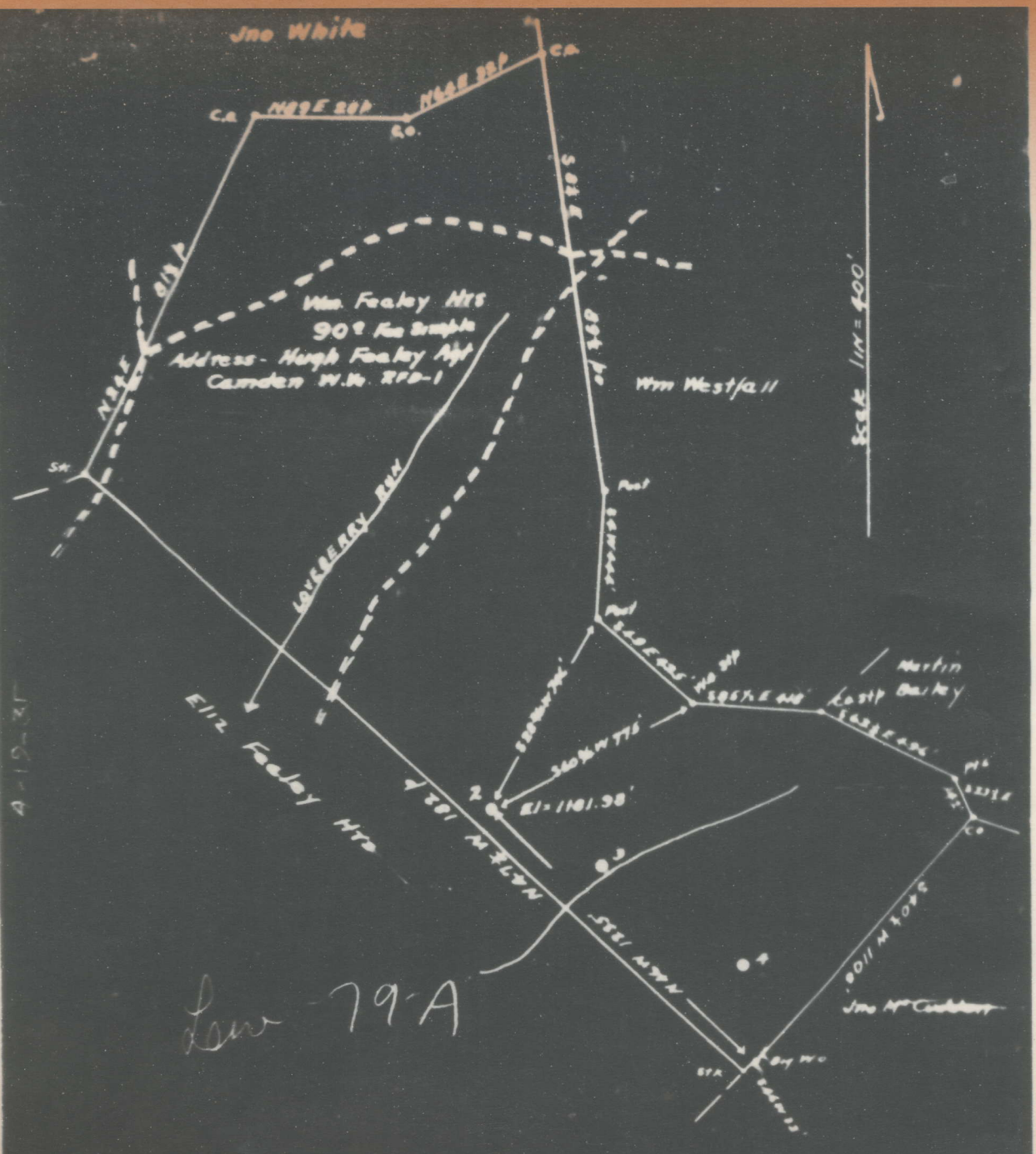

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by South Penn Oil Company, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 24th day of May, 19 35, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which said well was plugged:
Total Depth 1979'. Filled with non-porous material to 1933', - 20' above Maxon Sand. Set wood plug 1933' - 1930'. Set cement plug 1930' - 1920', - sealing Maxon Sand. Pulled 6-5/8" casing. Filled with non-porous material to 1858', - 30' below 2nd Salt Sand. Set wood plug 1858' - 1855'. Set cement plug 1855' - 1845', - Filled with non-porous material to 1088', - 20' above 1st Salt Sand. Set wood plug 1088' - 1085'. Set cement plug 1085' - 1075', - sealing Salt Sand. Pulled 8-1/4" casing. Filled with non-porous material to 830', - 20' above Big Dunkard Sand. Set wood plug 830' - 827'. Set cement plug 827' - 817', - sealing Big Dunkard Sand. Set bridge 482', - 40' below Pittsburgh coal. Set vent pipe 482' to surface. Vent pipe perforated 482' - 472'. Set Morning Glory racker 472', - 30' below Pittsburgh Coal. Cement vent pipe 472' to 415', - 20' above Pittsburgh Coal. Filled with non-porous material to surface.

Description of monument:

2" pipe 8' above ground 2" Tee 2 - 2" Elbs pointing downward; 2' cement cone around vent pipe 2' above ground.
