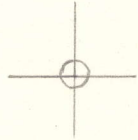

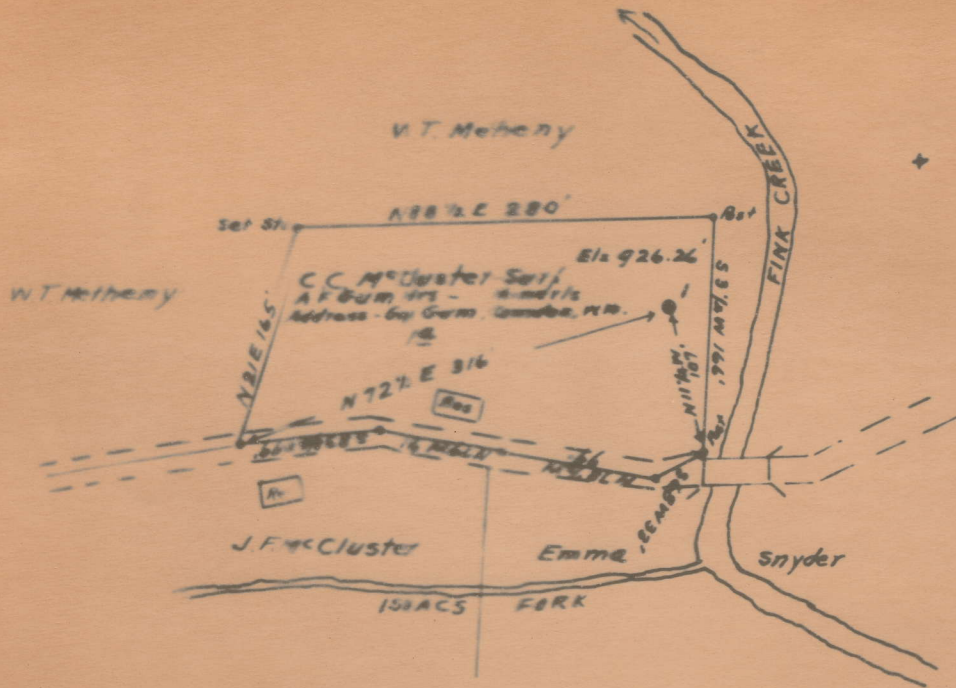
District FREEMANS CREEK

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by South Penn Oil Company, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 8th day of December, 1936, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged:

Total depth 2468'. Filled with non-porous material to 2412'. Set wood plug 2412'-2409'; set cement plug 2409'-2399', - sealing Fifth Sand. Lost tools; filled with non-porous material to 1755'. Set wood plug 1755'-1752'; set cement plug 1752'-1742', - sealing Gantz Sand. Set bridge 1626'. Pulled 16B'- 5-3/16" casing. Filled with non-porous material to 1595'. Set cement plug 1595'-1585'. Cut 6-5/8" casing at 800'. Set cement plug in casing 800'-810'. Cut 6-5/8" casing at different points; could only pull 292'. Set cement plug 292'-282', - sealing Little Dunkard Sand. Set cement plug ~~282'-272'~~ 282'-272'. Set bridge 116', - 40' below Pittsburgh Coal. Set Morning Glory Packer 106', - 30' below Pittsburgh Coal. Set 2" vent pipe 116' to surface. 10' perforated anchor below packer. Cement vent pipe 106' to 51', - 20' above Pittsburgh Coal. Fill with non-porous material to surface.

Description of monument: 2" pipe 8' above ground. 2" tee, 2 - 2" ellis pointing downward. 2' cement cone around vent pipe 2' above ground.
