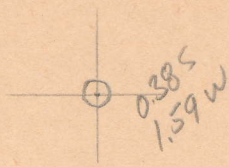
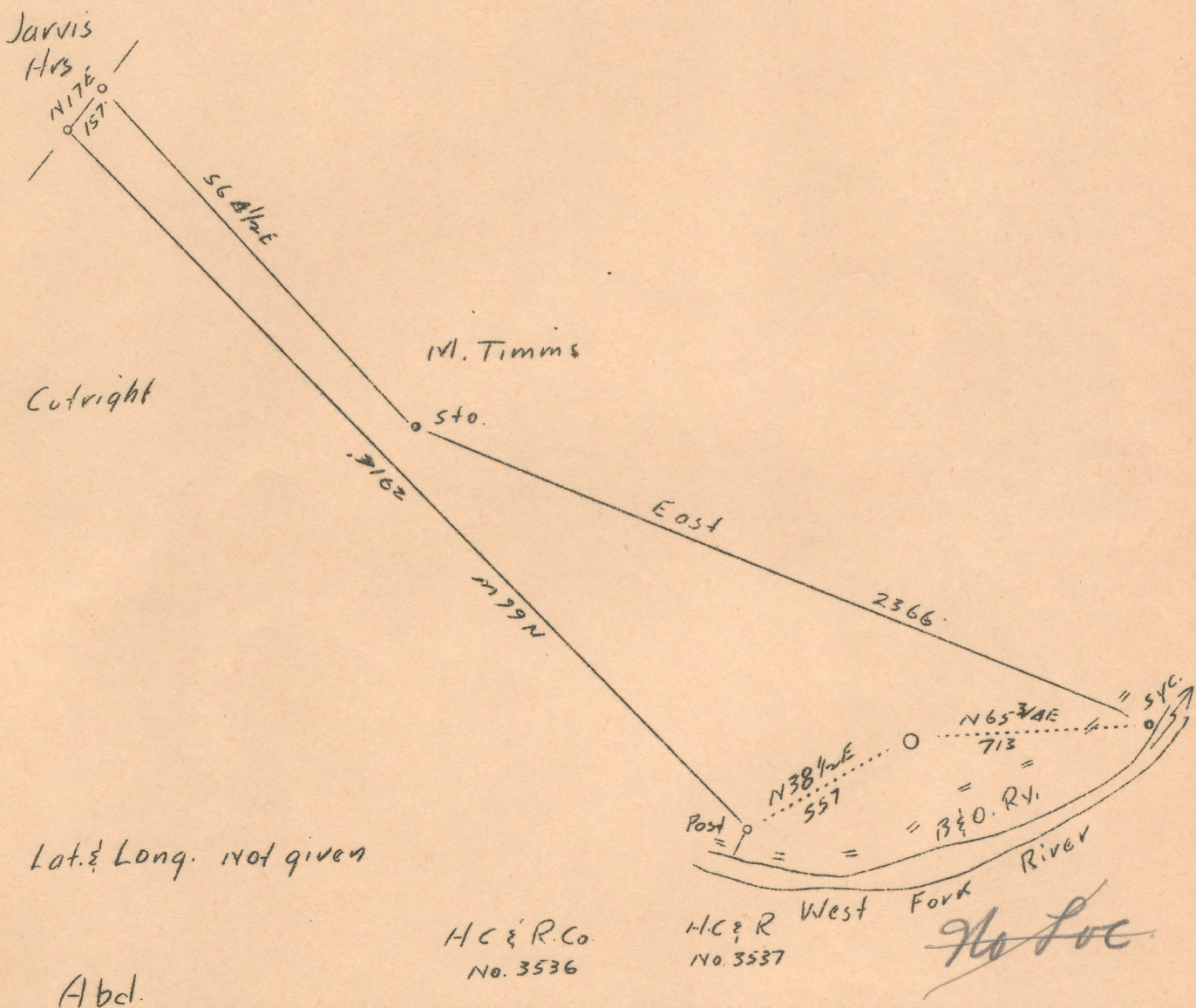

Leroy Cassady and Cecil Hall
being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Leroy Cassady well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 28 day of Jan., 19 38, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged: Filled with red clay from bottom 2502' to 2450'-10' below top of Gordon, set wood plug and cemented to 2457', continued to fill with clay to 2373', set wood plug and cemented to 2365'. Set a permanent bridge 2037' - 30' below squaw sand with one sack cement on a bridge, and filled with red clay from 2037' to 1993', wood plug and cemented to 1990', then filled as casing was pulled to 1835' and cemented to 1825', sealing hole in big lime. Set a permanent bridge at 1720' with one sack cement on bridge and filled with red clay to 1025' and cemented to 1015'. Filled with clay to 806'. Set a permanent bridge at 310' with one sack cement on bridge, filled to surface with clay.
Manner in which coal was plugged:

No coal present.
