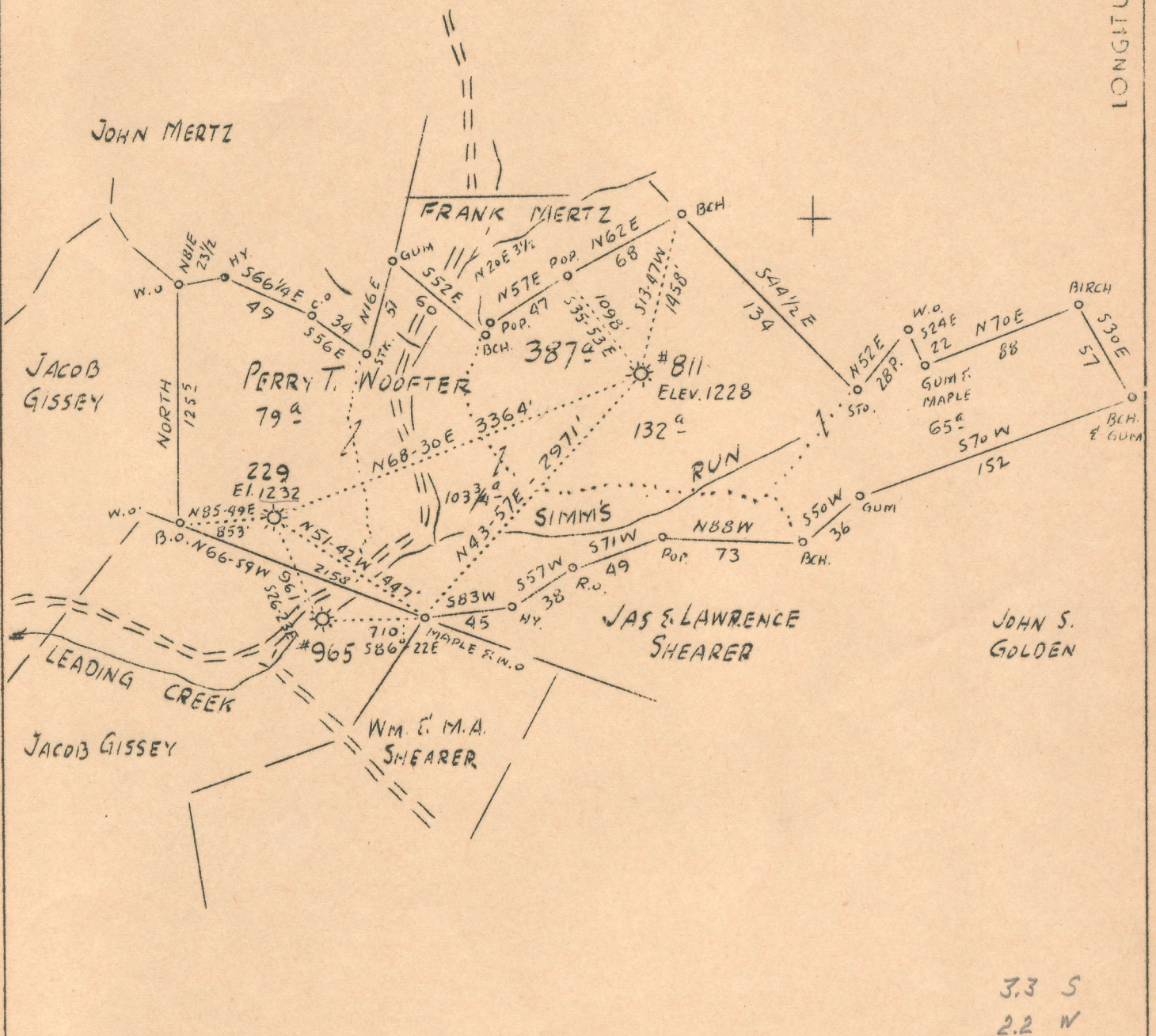

do hereby first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of

plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Reserve Gas Company, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work

commenced on the 22 day of August, 1938, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged: Filled with clay from total depth of 2592'. Set 5" Wood plug at 2566' and continued filling with clay to 2419'. Set 6" Wood plug at 2419'. Installed permanent bridge at 1930'. Filled solid with clay to 1818'. 6-3/8" Casing would not pull, cut same and pulled out 1866', leaving 52' in hole. Was able to set plug at 1782' on account of cutting 6-3/8" casing. Hole was filled solid from 1818 to 970' with clay. 1-3/4" Wood plug set at 970'. Filled hole solid with clay to 741'. 1-3/4" wood plug

Manner in which coal was plugged: Set 741'. Attempted to pull 6 1/2" casing, would not pull, parted same and pulled out 860', leaving 171' in hole. Installed bridge and wood plug at 551', attempted to remove 10" casing, parted same, pulling out 83', leaving 136' in hole. Filled with clay mud to 172'. Cemented hole solid from 172' to 80'. Filled hole solid from 80' to surface with clay and erected concrete monument over hole.

Description of monument:

Concrete with Company's name and well number extending 36" above surface of ground.

THE ABOVE DESCRIPTION MUST BE IN DETAIL AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 10, ARTICLE 4, CHAPTER 22 OF THE CODE.

That the work of plugging and filling said well was completed on the 6 day of Sept.
