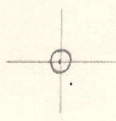

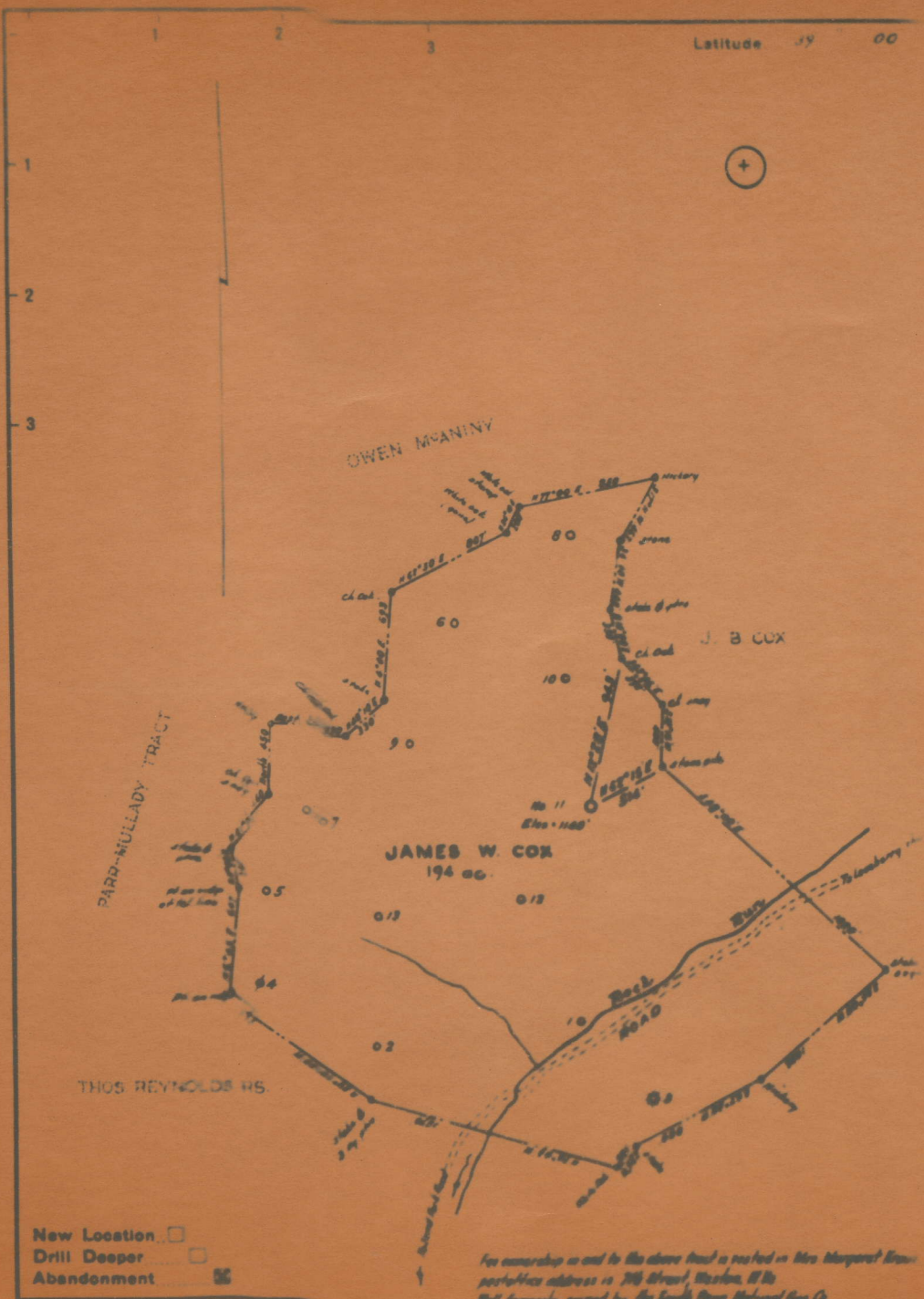
WELL LOCATION MAP

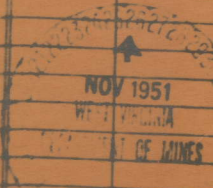

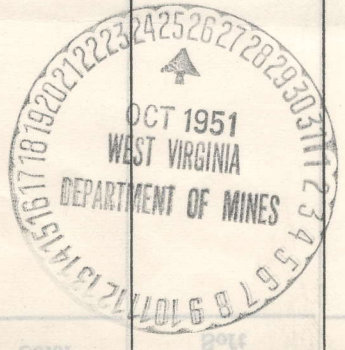
