being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by *Southern Oil Co.*, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the *18* day of *August*, 19*30*, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was <sup>first</sup> plugged: *Bridge at 2368 filled with Red Sand and sand pumping L 2300 with Two Wood plug 2 1/2" & female in proper place next bridge at 2200 then filled with red sand and one Wood plug 2 1/2" next bridge and plug on top of 6" beam at 1960 with 26 ft of cement on top.*

Manner in which coal was plugged: *8 in beam left in three the coal with 50 ft of cement in the in side bridge set at 1060 a little filling then cement a another bridge and plug on top of 8 in beam at 760 with 30 ft of cement on top to 730 and a another bridge at 250 ft filled with stone and Red Sand and sand pumping to 28 ft of the top then cement to top.*

Description of monument: *Cement 20 in in diameter 18 in above ground with name & date on it*
