being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by F. G. Bish, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 28th day of September, 1933, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged:
Filled up with Clay from bottom of Big Injun sand to 1975 20ft above Big Injun- placed wood plug at 1975 with 10 feet of cement on top of plug-
Cut the 6 5/8" casing off at 1200 feet on account not being able to pull- removed 1200 feet casing- Wood plug at 1200 feet with 10 feet of cement placed on top of plug. Anchored permanent bridge at ~~740~~ 740 feet filled with stone to 718 feet (40 feet below Pgh Coal) placed string 2" pipe to surface of ground.

Manner in which coal was plugged:
String of 2" pipe placed in hole 40 feet below Pgh Coal with perforation near bottom- Mop packer on above perforation. Filled with cement to 652 (20 feet above Pgh Coal) Filled with clay to surface

Description of monument:
Erected concrete monument 10" square and 3ft high with a base 30" square and 24" under surface with 2" pipe extending above monument with top perforated
