#### WELL WORK PLUGGING PERMIT

#### Plugging

This permit, API Well Number: 47-6101335, issued to NOUMENON CORPORATION, is evidence of permission granted to perform the specified well work at the location described on the attached pages and located on the attached plat, subject to the provisions of Chapter 22 of the West Virginia Code of 1931, as amended, and all rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, and to all conditions and provisions outlined in the pages attached hereto. Notification shall be given by the operator to the Oil and Gas Inspector at least 24 hours prior to the construction of roads, locations, and/or pits for any permitted work. In addition, the well operator shall notify the same inspector 24 hours before any actual well work is commenced and prior to running and cementing casing. Spills or emergency discharges must be promptly reported by the operator to 1-800-642-3074 and to the Oil and Gas inspector.

Upon completion of the plugging well work, the above named operator will reclaim the site according to the provisions of WV Code 22-6-30. The above named operator will also file, as required in WV Code 22-6-23, an affidavit on form WR-38 by two experienced persons in the operator's employment and the Oil and Gas inspector that the work authorized under this permit was performed and a description given. Failure to abide by all statutory and regulatory provisions governing all duties and operations here under may result in suspensions or revocation of this permit and in addition may result in civil and/or criminal penalities being imposed upon the operator.

#### Application for Permit to Plug or Abandon Section 10-Work Order

API Well No: 47-061-01335-C

Operator Well #: 11L2

Well History: Well 11L2 which was converted in 1998 to a Coal Bed Methane recovery well, previously the well had been installed as a Degas/Ventilation hole to support deep mining operations of the CONSOL Humphrey No. 7 Mine which was located in the Pittsburgh coal seam. According to Mr. Roger Duckworth, 37 Sand Plant Rd, Worthington, WV 26591 who was employed by CONSOL for many years and whose primary responsibility was to manage the DeGas development operations within the mine area the following procedures were used to construct the Degas Wells: The wells were generally drilled to the Sewickley Coal seam or approximately 90-100 feet above the Pittsburgh coal seam. The holes were cased and cemented in with solid steel pipe of varying diameters through the Waynesburg coal seam. Below the Waynesburg coal a slotted steel pipe was installed to the Sewickley Coal Seam. It was generally understood that the strata that broke above the mine due to subsidence would typically roofed out in or around the Sewickley Horizon this allowed the methane gas to then vent through the holes and the slotted pipe helped maintain an open pathway to the surface if the strata shifted.

Casing Diameter: 8" Casing Thickness: 1/2" Casing Reported Depth: 556.0'

Estimated Casing Weight: 15,874 lbs. Required lifting Capacity: 23,811 lbs.

Casing Retrieval (35-4-13.6): Noumenon Corporation will make a reasonable effort to cut and pull all recoverable casing from the well. Noumenon Corporation proposes to use a Bucyrus-Erie 28L Spudder Rig or other similar type equipment with a lifting capacity of at least 150% the estimated weight of the casing to perform the extraction process. If the pipe can be removed it will be brought to the surface in manageable lengths and cut using a Hydraulic Cut off saw, the pipe will be stockpiled for later removal or loaded immediately onto a trailer for removal to the Noumenon supply yard or taken straight to a salvage yard. If the casing cannot be pulled with reasonable effort then the operator will make reasonable attempts to perforate the pipe and squeeze cement behind the pipe in the grouting process so as to prevent contamination of the fresh water zone.



Plugging Methods (35-4-14): The operator shall remove/bail all oils and or salt waters from the well prior to initiating the plugging process. The operator will install a bottom plug that is 100 feet thick from the base of the well using API Class A Portland Hydraulic Cement (with a Calcium Chloride content of 3% or less and no other additives) On top of the bottom plug the operator may install a Spacer plug of 6% Bentonite gel using a mixture rate of 100 lbs per 5bbl of water. The operator would then install a top or surface plug of cement as per the criteria mentioned above, a minimum of 100' feet below the surface. The Cement grout and bentonite gel shall be placed in the hole under pressure using a tremie tube and grout pump. No workable coal seams lie above the Sewickley coal seam.

Plugging and Well Records (35-4-12.1): The operator and or contractor hired to perform the plugging shall maintain a log or records of such detail that the entries and related data on Form WR-38 "Affidavit of Plugging and Filling Well" can be completed. The WR-38 shall reflect all data discovered or changes made after the permitted well work has been finished.

**Reclamation of the Site:** Upon completion of the well plugging all equipment, piping and other debris from the plugging operation shall be removed from the site. All disturbance created by the plugging or access to the well site shall be reclaimed and vegetated to prevent erosion and sedimentation. The operator shall use utilize WV Department of Environmental Protections Best Management Practices as the criteria for Erosion and Sediment Control and revegetation.

Monument: Upon completion of the site reclamation and in conjunction with the closure of the well the operator shall install a monument in accordance with 35-4-(5) (b) and as follows:

- 1. The monument shall be made of steel pipe.
- 2. The diameter shall be 6"
- The pipe shall be imbedded into the well head 10 feet below the surface level and protrude 30" above the ground surface.
- 4. The pipe shall be sealed with concrete cement.
- 5. The API Number shall painted onto the pipe in 1/2" height numbering.

Responsible Parties: The operator, contractors and drillers including all service companies are directed that they shall comply with WV Code 22-6

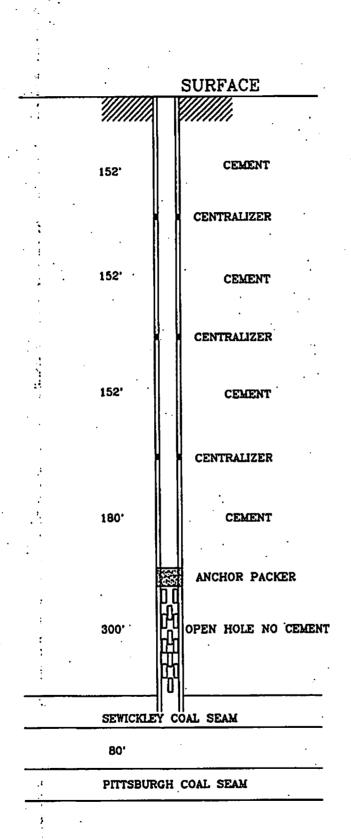

Within 750 horizontal feet and 100 vertical feet of the Pittsburgh coal seam, there are no workable coal seams due to the thickness, quality, and marketability as per the WV Geological Survey Reports of 1913 for Monongalia County.

According to the WV Geological Report, the General Interval for the coal seams located above the Pittsburgh coal seam are:

Washington	510 feet	approximate thickness 2.0
Waynesburg-A	420 feet	approximate thickness 2.0
Waynesburg	360 feet	approximate thickness 5.0

You may add other documents, such as sketches, maps or photographs to support your comments.

The Chief has the power to deny or condition a well work permit based on comments on the following grounds:

- 3) Damage would occur to publicly owned lands or resources;
- 4) The proposed well work fails to protect fresh water sources or supplies;
- 5) The applicant has committed a substantial violation of a previous permit or a substantial violation of one or more of the rules promulgated under Chapter 22, and has failed to abate or seek review of the violation...".

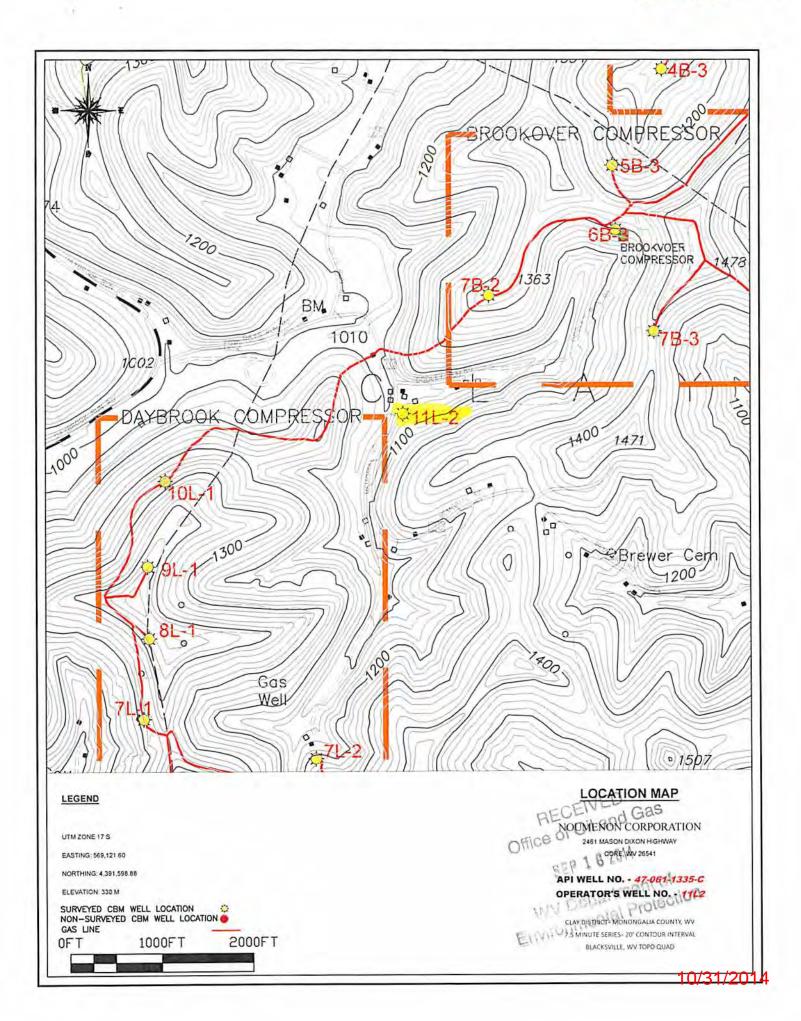
