PROPOSED MANNER OF PLUGGING AND FILLING WELL

(REQUIREMENT BY RULES AND REGULATIONS)

WORK ORDER

Well to be plugged and filled as follows:

Depth of Well - 2550'

Big Injun Sand - 2550' to 2355'. Mud filled thru this sand and a wood, then a cement plug placed at top Big Line - 2355' to 2302'. Mud filled up to a point 20'0" above Big Line; Cement plug at this point.

Salt Sand - 2048' to 1905'. Bridge at 30'0" below salt sand and fill with mud to a point 20'0" above salt sand. Cement plug at this point. Mud filled up to 1093'.

Pittsburgh Coal 1153' to 1046'. Cement from 1083' to 1026'. (30'0" below to 20'0" above Pop Coal.)

Sewickley Coal 953' to 947'. Cement from 983' to 927'. (30'0" below to 20'0" above Sewickley C.) Mud to top of hole. Concrete markers as per rule 18 of 1931 Regulations.
