 no gas at all.  
 Bottom hole packer put in with 5-3/16" casing.  
 From bottom of casing to top of Bayard, 996 feet.  
 Bottom of liner 2975' below surface of hole and 2405' below top  
 of Pittsburgh Coal.  
 10' conductor; 10" casing, 580'; 8 1/2", 1075'; 6-5/8", 1560';  
 5-3/16", 1985'; 4" liner, 523', in two sections, 271' in  
 1st and 252' in 2nd; bottom joint perforated.  
 Shot Mar. 26, 1904, by C. C. Fisher, with 24 qts., 12' shell,  
 4' anchor; depth of well when shot, 2997'; depth, top of  
 shot, 2981'; good results.
