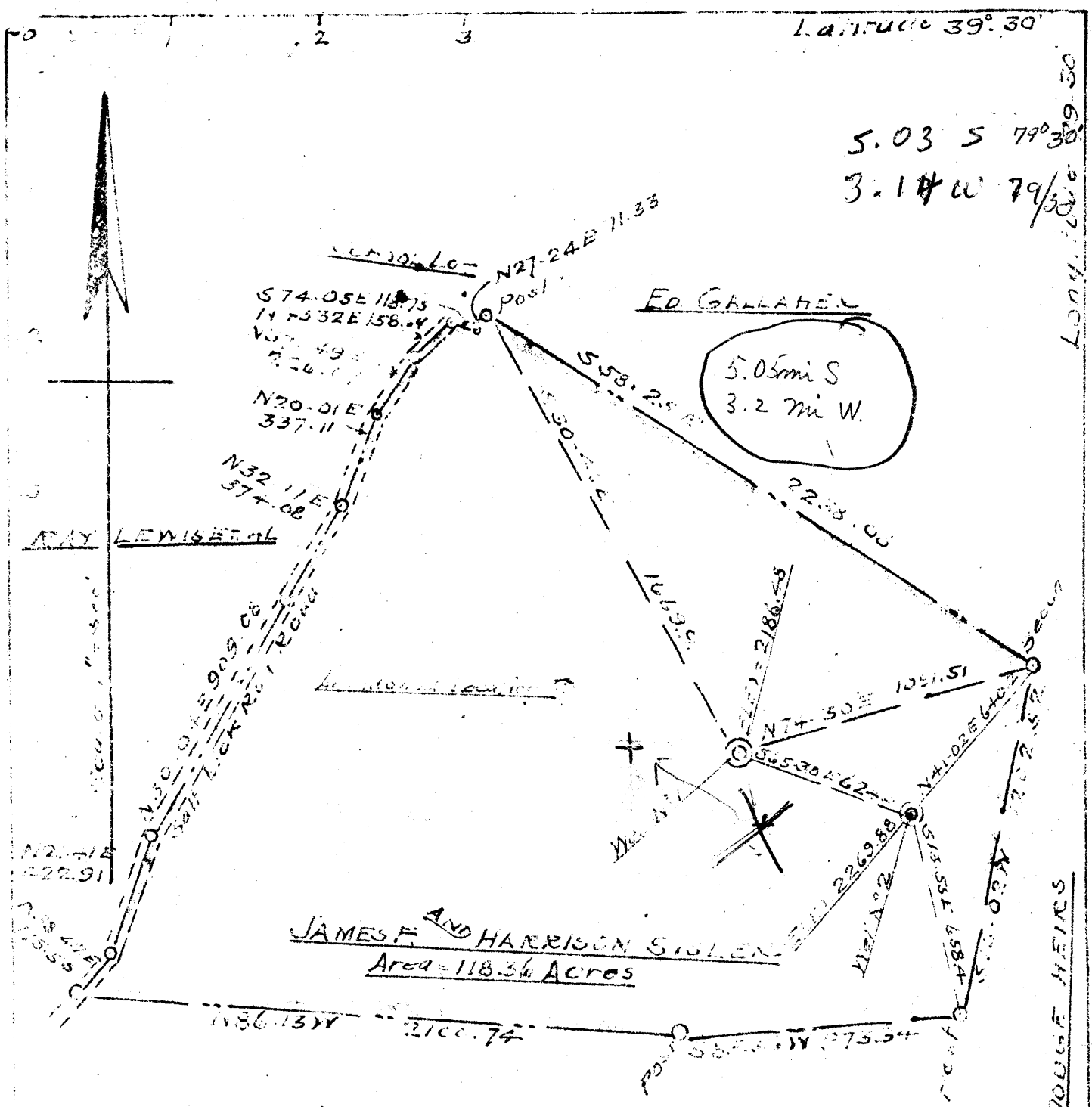

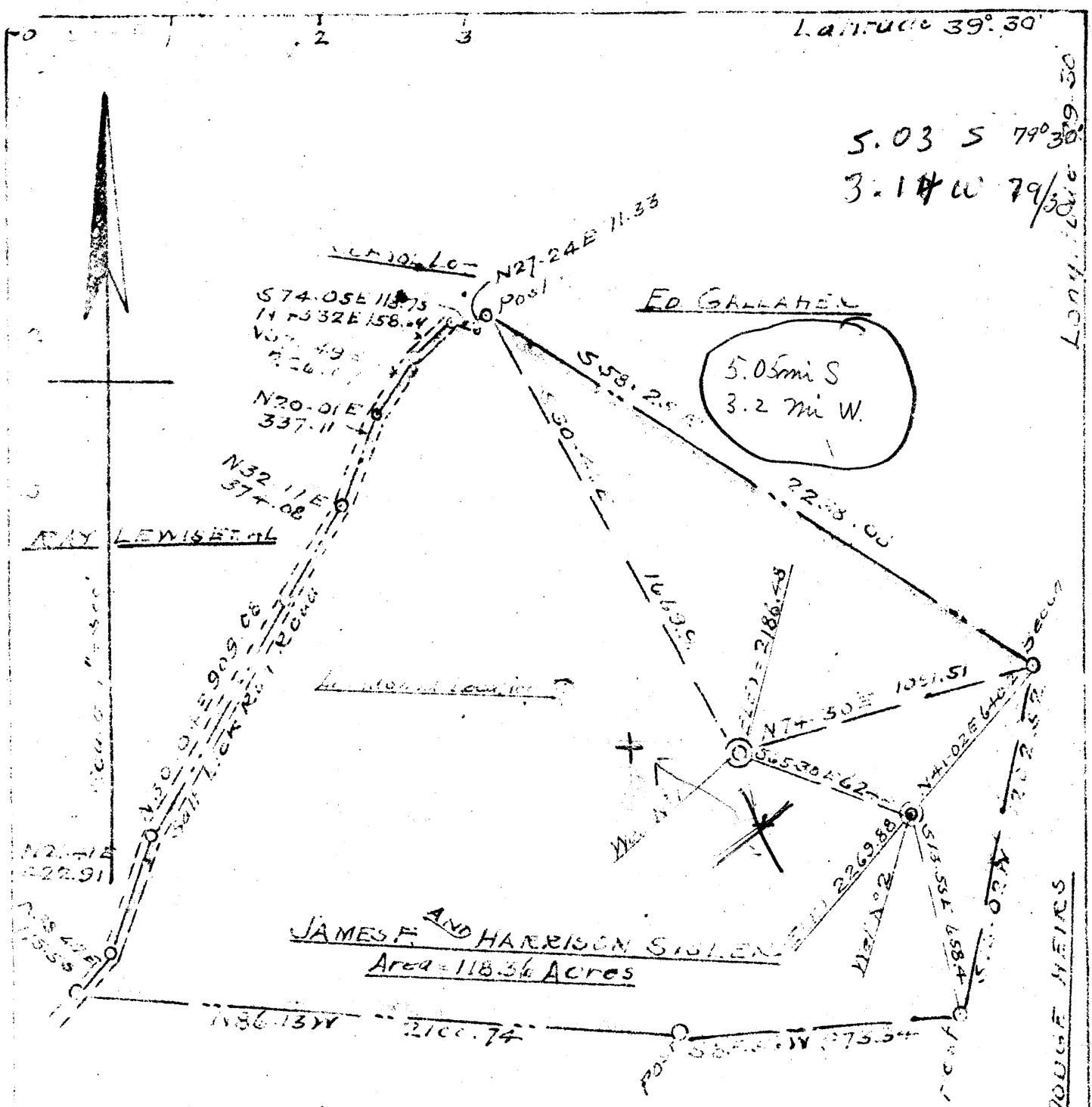

Re.: Well #2 on James F. & Harrison Sisler Farm
Portland Dist., Preston Co., W. Va.

The following is a report concerning the above well in response to your letters to me of Apr. 19, 1955 & May 17, 1955:

- Mar. 28, 1946 Tubed with 4.7# 2" tubing to 6236 ft.
Bottom of packer rubber 5738 ft.
No leaks. Open flow 4.5 " Water in 1" orifice 71 MCF
- Mar. 29, 1946 Put in 100 sacks of cement on top packer & aqua jelled to top.
- Aug. 23, 1946 Pressure after shut in from Aug. 17 th. to Aug. 23 rd. 2300 # Open flow when shut in 49 MCF/Day
- Oct. 8, 1946 Pressure 2340 #.
- Oct. 16, 1946 Dowell treated with 2500 gal. low surface tension acid & 1000 gal water load.
- Oct. 18, 1946 Open flow 135 MCF/Day.
- Nov. 2, 1946 Finished tubing with 3/4 " hung in well, no packer, Joint perforated with 1/4 " holes every 6 " set at 6100 ft. (30 ft. below lowest gas pay), also 1 1/4" hole each joint to bottom & 1/8 " hole each 100 ft. up from 6100 ft. for 4 joints (uppermost perforation a little above 5738 ft.
- Dec. 1, 1946 Dowell treated with 6000 gal. Open flow before treatment 2.9 " Water in 1 1/4 " orifice.
- Dec. 20, 1946 Started to market gas from well.
- Apr. 1, 1947 Producing into pipeline approx. 84 MCF/Day.
- Dec. 21, 1947 Producing into pipeline approx. 145 MCF/Day.
- Dec. 24, 1947 Blew well. Open flow 45 min. after blowing 152 MCF/Day. Still could smell acid but very little moisture.

I hope the above completes the information you desire and I'm sorry for the long delay in getting it to you.
