1. Notify OOG Inspector. Notification is required 24 hours prior to commencing the plugging.

TIH to check TD 2155'. (Well record shows 2209'/10" casing but most other records in this area have shown less than a joint of 10" has been ran and the 2" tubing would have been ran to 2209').

2. TOH and then pull all tubing including any packer. Contact inspector how to proceed if can't pull.
3. There is no mention of any cement on any casing strings in this well. Contact inspector for need to run bond log(s) to determine cement and top(s). All casing in this well that is not bonded by cement and cannot be retrieved must be perforated at point approved by the inspector.
4. TIH with tubing to TD. Pump gel followed by bottom hole cement plug 2103'-2003'(gas Berea top 2123'). Pull up hole and WOC.
5. Tag plug and pump gel followed by cement plug 1658'-1558' (Big Injun top at 1678').
6. TOH and try pulling 6 5/8" casing set at 1428'. Unable to pull then try to free point cut/pull. If casing shoe to be left in place put cement plug 10' below and 90' above it (100' plug). Contact inspector, per item 3 above for points of interest to perforate casing.
7. Pump gel followed by cement plug 1368'-1268' (Little Lime top 1388').
8. Pump gel followed by cement plug 880'- 680' (Gas sand top 900'). - SW 940'
9. Pump gel followed by cement plug 100' to surface.
10. Erect monument with API number affixed.

11. NOTE.....Any casing found in the well without cement in the annulus that cannot be retrieved must be perforated and cemented at all saltwater, freshwater, coal, oil , gas and largest casing shoe.
