Said coal operators are further notified that forms for use in making such objections will be furnished to them by the Department of Mines promptly on request and that all such objections must set forth as definitely as is reasonably possible the ground or grounds on which such objections are based and indicate the direction and distance the proposed location should be moved to overcome same.

**PROPOSED MANNER OF PLUGGING AND FILLING WELL**

(REQUIRED BY RULES AND REGULATIONS)

**WORK ORDER**

Well to be plugged and filled as follows:

WORK ORDER SUPPLIED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MINES:

Fill with red clay from the bottom 1820' to 1590' - 20' above the Big Injun Sand.  
Drive wood plug from 1590' to 1587'  
Cement from 1587' to 1577' sealing the Big Injun Sand.

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 1440' - 30' below the 3d Salt Sand.  
Fill with clay from 1440' to 1113' - 13' below the 6-5/8" casing  
Drive wood plug from 1113' to 1110'  
Cement from 1110' to 1100'

PULL 6-5/8" casing set at 1100'

Continue to fill with clay or other non-porous material from 1100' to 405'  
5' below the 8" casing  
Drive wood plug from 405' to 402'  
PULL 8-1/4" casing set at 400'

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 140' - 40' below the 10" casing  
Fill with clay from 140' to 103'  
Drive wood plug from 103' to 100'  
PULL 10" casing and  
Continue to fill with clay to the surface

Erect a marker such as is described in Rule 18, 1931 Regulations

All be done in a workman-like manner
