The undersigned well operator is informed and believes there are no coal operators operating beds of coal beneath said farm or tract of land on which said well is located, or within 500 feet of the boundaries of the same, who have mapped their workings and filed their maps as required by law, excepting the coal operators or coal owners (if any) above named as addressees.

The above named coal operators or coal owners (if any) are notified that any objections they may desire to make to such proposed location, or which they are required to make by Section 3 of said Act, if the drilling of a well at said proposed location will cause a dangerous condition in or about their respective coal mines, must be received by, or filed with the Department of Mines within ten* days from the receipt of a copy of this notice and accompanying plat by said Department. Said coal operators are further notified that forms for use in making such objections will be furnished to them by the Department of Mines promptly on request and that all such objections must set forth as definitely as is reasonably possible the ground or grounds on which such objections are based and indicate the direction and distance the proposed location should be moved to overcome same.

(REQUIRED BY RULES AND REGULATIONS)

WORK ORDER

Well to be plugged and filled as follows:

WORK ORDER SUPPLIED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MINES:

Bottom of well 2216'

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 1877' - 30' below the Big Injun Sand. Fill with clay or other non-porous material from 1877' to 1735' Drive wood plug from 1735' to 1732' Cement from 1732' to 1722' sealing the hole completely.

Continue to fill with clay from 1722' to 1625' Drive wood plug from 1625' to 1622'

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 1353' Fill with clay from 1353' to 1037'-3' below the 8 1/4" casing Drive wood plug from 1037' to 1034' PULL 8 1/4" casing and Fill with clay from 1034' to 1024'

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 500'

Fill with clay from 500' to the surface and Erect a marker such as is described in Rule 18, 1931 Regulations.

All be done in a workman-like manner.

To the Department of Mines, Coal Owner or Operator, Lease or Property Owner.

Gentlemen:

This "work order" is submitted for your approval and concurrence and unless notified of your disapproval or non-concurrence, the undersigned will proceed with the plugging and filling of said well in the above described manner on the date stated in the notice of intention to plug and abandon the said well on opposite side of this sheet.
