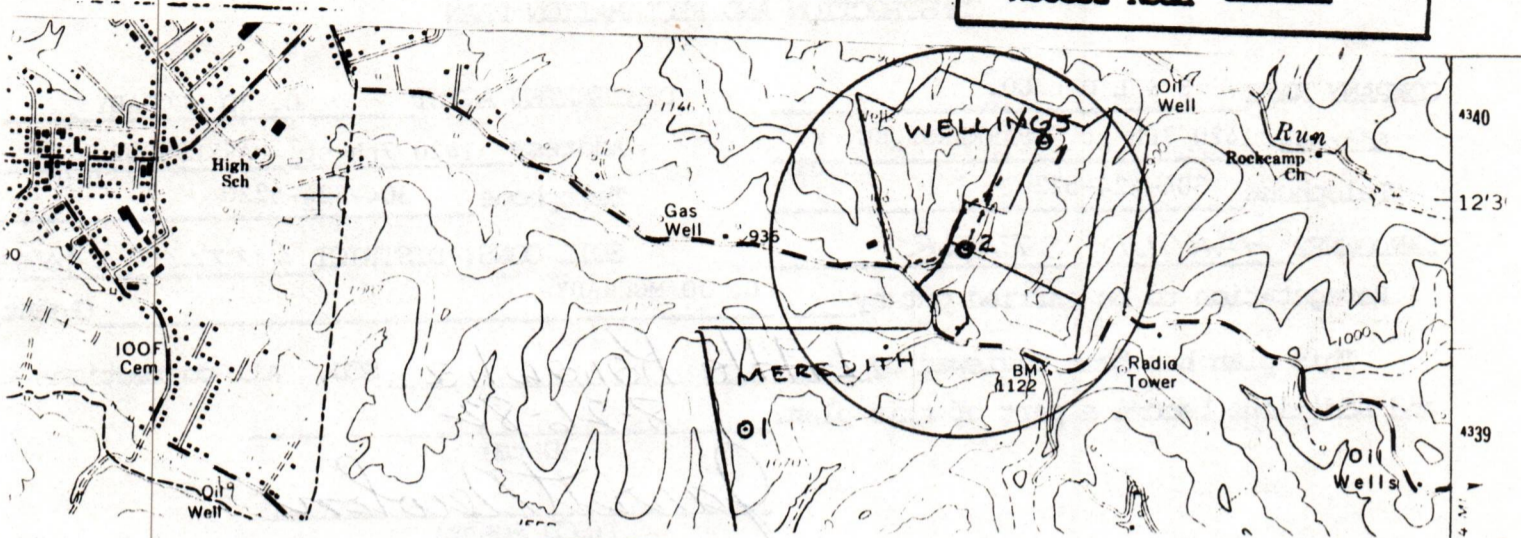

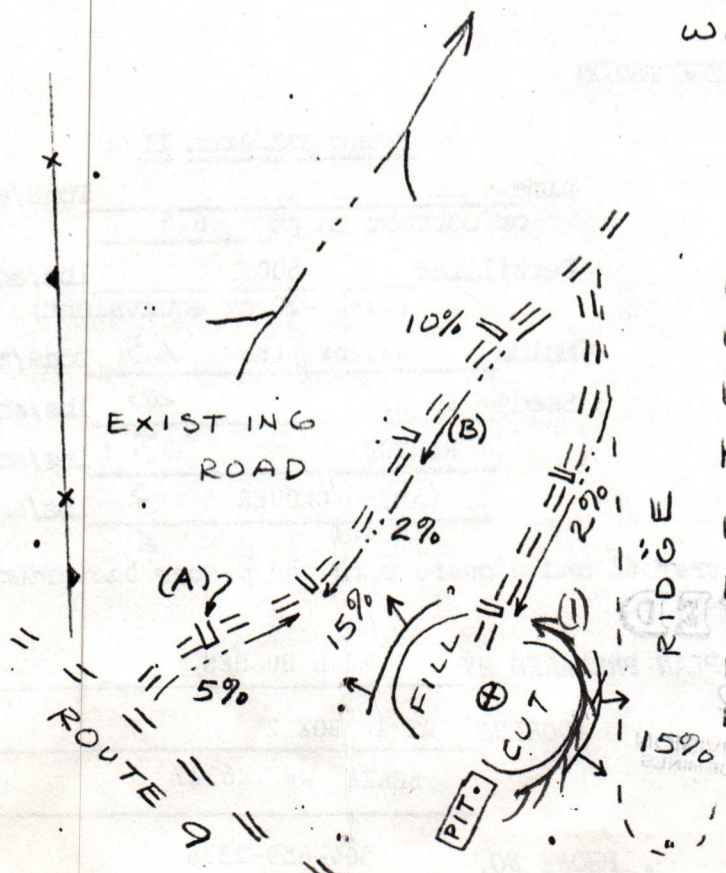

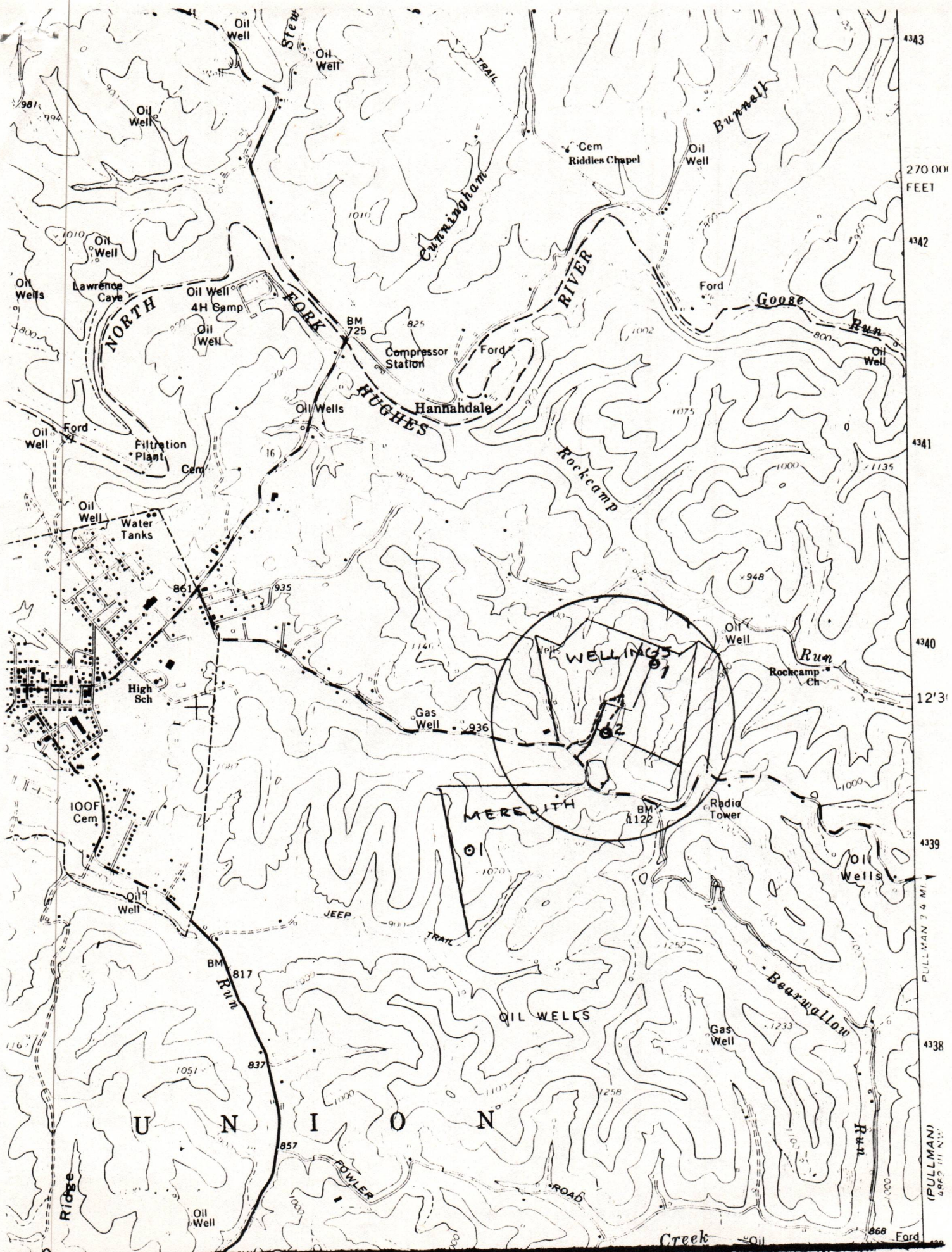

THIS CORRECTION DEED, made this 23rd day of May, 1942, by and between Margaret A. Hall, a single woman, of Harrisville, West Virginia, party of the first part, and John E. Wellings and Nellie L. Wellings, husband and wife, of Ritchie County, West Virginia, parties of the second part.

WHEREAS, by deed dated the 28th day of March, 1935, of record in the office of the Clerk of the County Court of Ritchie County, West Virginia, the said Margaret A. Hall conveyed to the said John E. Wellings, a certain lot, tract or parcel of land situate in the District of Union, County of Ritchie and State of West Virginia, as described in said deed, and being the unsold portion of four tracts of land instead of three tracts, as mentioned in said original deed, inherited by the said party of the first part from her father, T. F. Leach, said conveyance being in bulk and not by the acre; and

WHEREAS, the said parties of the second part have caused said tract of land to be surveyed by A. K.
