INTRODUCTION

This Order (hereinafter “Order”) is issued by the Office of Oil and Gas (hereinafter “OOG”), by and through its Chief, pursuant to the authority of West Virginia Code §§ 22-1-1 *et seq.*, 22-6- 2, 22-11-1 *et seq.* and 22-12-1 *et seq.* to Jay-Bee Oil & Gas, Inc.

FINDINGS OF FACT

In support of this Order, the Chief hereby finds the following:

1. Jay-Bee Oil & Gas, Inc. was issued underground injection control (UIC) permit number 2D08510284 from the Office of Oil and Gas to inject Class 2 compliant waste fluids from oil and natural gas exploration and development into well API # 47-085-10284. UIC permit 2D08510284 was issued on May 2, 2019, with an expiration date of May 2, 2024.

2. Jay-Bee Oil & Gas, Inc. submitted a reissuance application package to renew UIC permit 2D08510284 on November 6, 2023.
3. The Office of Oil and Gas is currently reviewing the reissuance application package for UIC permit 2D08510284.

ORDER FOR COMPLIANCE

Therefore, in accordance with West Virginia Code §§ 22-1-1 et seq., 22-6-2, 22-11-1 et seq. and 22-12-1 et seq. it is hereby ORDERED by the Chief that:

Jay-Bee Oil & Gas, Inc. is hereby authorized for continued injection operations into well API # 47-085-10284 under the provisions of underground injection control permit 2D08510284 until the pending reissuance permit is issued or denied.
