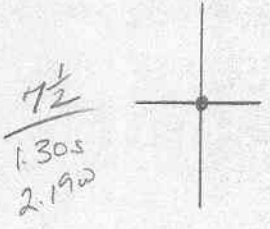

This well starts 22 feet by hand-level below the Pittsburgh coal. The well was drilled to a depth of 559 1/2 feet below the Bayard sand and only a light flow of gas encountered in the Big Injun.
