The following information on the completion of the above mentioned well should be added to the completion report (Form OG-10) already on file in your office:

Cemented lower hole solid from 2731' to 2088' (100 bags cement) and ran 2088 feet of 1 1/2" casing. Perforated from 1918' to 1998' with 16 holes and fractured 11-27-71 with 30,000# sand, 520 bbl water and 2500 HHP

The final open flow was 152,000 ^{MCF} cubic feet and the rock pressure was 215 pounds in 7 days/hours.
