SHOWS: An excellent show of gas was encountered in the 3rd Salt Sand. Additional shows of gas were noted on the mud log in the Rhinestreet, Alexander, Benson, Riley, Bayard, Gordon, Gantz and Big Injun. Dull yellow fluorescence and dull yellow hydrocarbon cut were noted in the Gordon samples.

GEOLOGY:

I would first recommend completion of the Rhinestreet Shale, Alexander, Benson and Riley Sandstones. The Rhinestreet Shale (5580 to 5644') and Alexander Sandstone (5502-5540') should be completed as the first stage. Both show only fair development, but together should contribute some gas reserves. The Rhinestreet had fair porosities and low water saturations. The temperature log, gas detector and mud logs indicated small shows of gas in this zone. The Alexander also showed fair porosities and low water saturations. The temperature and mud logs recorded small shows of gas in this zone.

The second stage would be the Benson (5260 to 5268'), which showed better development than expected for this area. It has fair to good porosities and low water saturations. The temperature and mud logs indicated a small show of gas. The third stage would be the Riley (4816-4846'), which had the second best gas show (the best being in the 3rd Salt Sand, discussed later) in the well. It has good porosities and low water saturations. The temperature and mud logs indicated good shows of gas in this zone (background of 180 units to a maximum of 314 and 342 units).

After depletion of the lower zones, addition production may be obtained from the Bayard, Gordon, Gantz and 3rd Salt Sand. The Bayard, 3148 to 3164', has fair to good porosities and low water saturations. The temperature and mud logs indicated a small show of gas in this zone. The Gordon will be severely depleted in this area because of many old well. However, because of the very high porosity and very good thickness, some reserves may remain. After depletion of any other zones in this well, testing of this zone should be considered. A compressor may be needed to lower the wellhead pressure enough to obtain significant gas. Because of the fluorescence and oil cut, I would expect this zone to make some small amount of oil. The Gantz, 2700 to

2720', also showed good development in this well. However, it is also subject to severe depletion. The 3rd Salt Sand would appear to have the best production potential in this well. An excellent show of gas (background of 8 units to a maximum of 2125 units) was noted at 1980'. Because it is behind the 7" casing, we only have a gamma ray log across this zone. When the lower zones are perforated, I recommend running a gamma ray-neutron across this zone for further evaluation. This zone should be tested after depletion of the lower zones.
