"Probably 28' Keener Sand".

"This record may show the true occurrence of Big Lime, Keener, and Big Injun Sands, together with breaks between. Possibly it does not and that the base of the Big Lime here indicates the true top of the Big Injun Sand. In several localities where Keener Sand is recorded the Big Lime is very thin, in some instances not over 10 feet in thickness. In this case Keener Sand evidently indicates Greenbrier Series connections. Breaks occur both at the base of the Big Lime and at the top of the Big Injun Sand so that this item is not an exacting criterion."
