PROPOSED MANNER OF PLUGGING AND FILLING WELL

(REQUIRED BY RULES AND REGULATIONS)

WEST VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF MINES

WORK ORDER

Well to be plugged and filled as follows:

Fill hole with red mud or other non porous material from bottom (1920) to 1836, which point is 50 feet above top of shot.

Cement plug 1836 to 1826', with crushed rock 1826 to 1821'.

Open hole from 1821 to 1600', which point is approximately 50 feet below 7" casing.

Set permanent bridge at 1600' and fill with red mud etc. to 1554', which point is bottom of 7" casing. Start pulling 7" casing and continue filling with red mud etc. to 1245', which point is 30' above top of Injun sand.

Cement plug ~~1245~~ 1245 to 1235', crushed rock 1235 to 1230'.

Fill with red mud etc. from 1230 to 825' which point is 30' above gas sand.

Cement plug 825 to 815', with crushed rock 815 to 810'.

Open hole from 810 to 465', which point is 50 feet below water.

Set permanent bridge at 465' and fill with red mud etc. to 340', which point is bottom of 8" casing. Start pulling 8" casing and continue filling with red mud etc to surface.

Erect a concrete marker 30 inches above ground, showing company name, well number and date of abandonment.

Note: Cement for plugs to be mixed with water only. Approximately 5 gal. of water to one sack of cement.

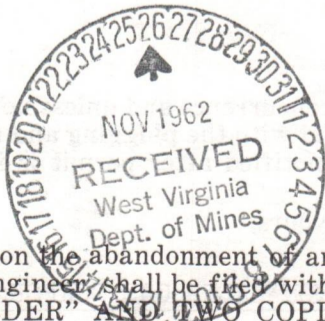

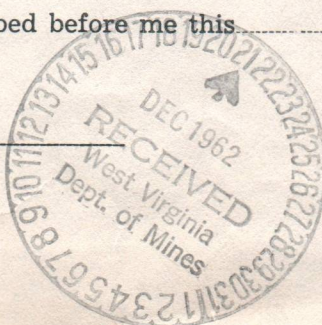

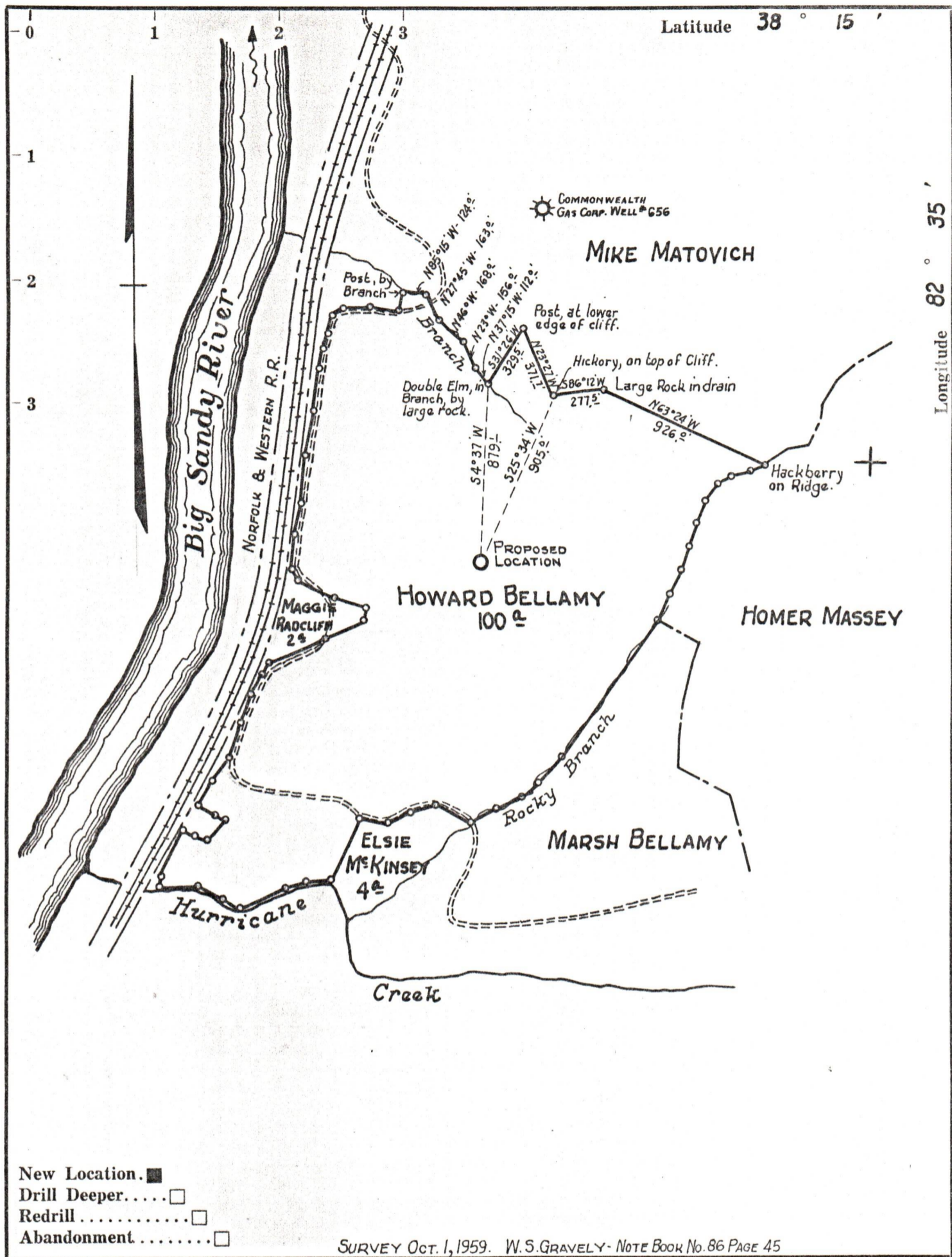
