
With reference to our telephone conversation of August 17, 1961, I wish to inform you that Commonwealth Gas Corporation's Well No. 662 on the Maxie McGee farm, Permit No. Wayne 1252, is at the present being drilled through the horizon of the Clinton Sand.

As I told you in our telephone conversation, we plan to plug this well back to the base of the Corniferous Lime and either fracture or shoot the Corniferous, if the Clinton Sand proves to be non-productive.

If we decide to do this, our method of plugging will be to fill the hole solid from the bottom to a point thirty feet above the top of the Clinton Sand with red mud or some other non-porus material, then we will fill the next ten feet with cement, with five feet of crushed rock on top of the cement, then we will continue filling with red mud, etc. to the base of the Corniferous Lime.

We will furnish a complete log of this well showing exactly what has been done when it has been completed.

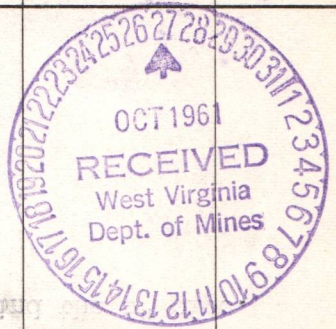

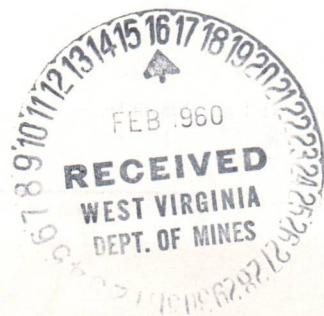

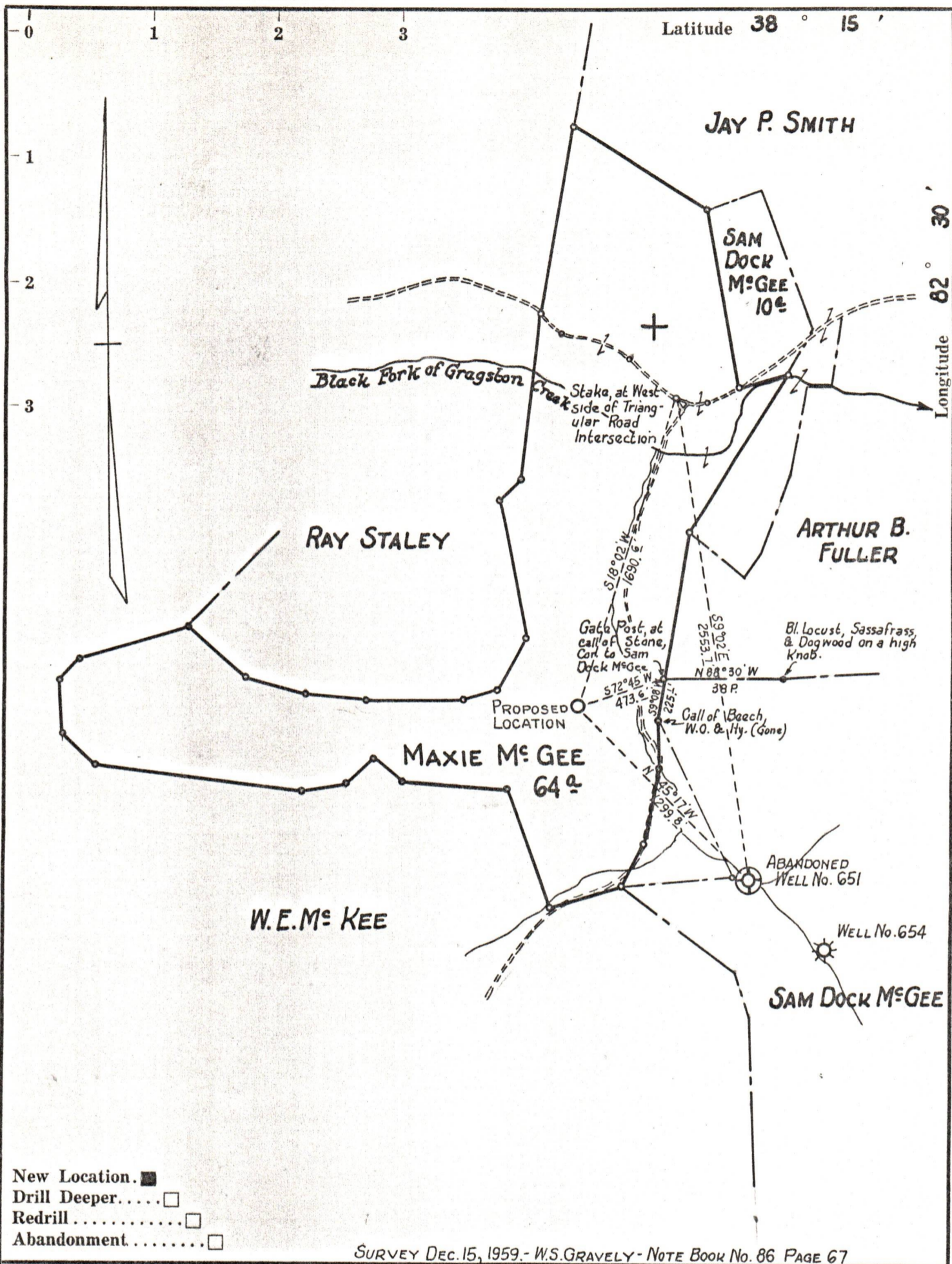
