Dear Mr. Courtney:

On November 12 I sent you a copy of a work order for the Manufacturers Light & Heat Company - Well No. 3530 on the Harry Palmer Farm, Proctor District, Wetzel County. I believe I also sent you a copy of the log and casing record.

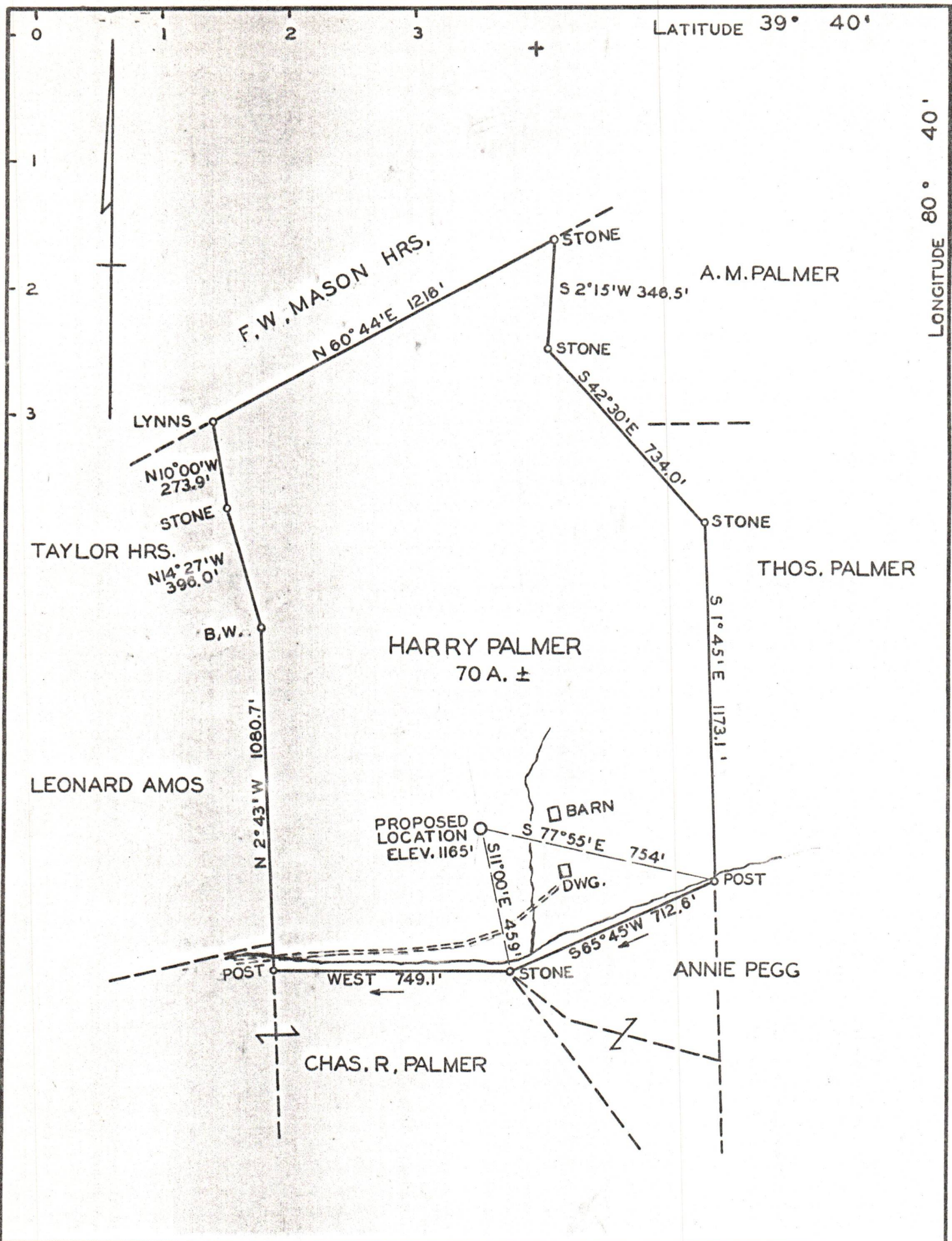
A notice was added on the bottom of the work order to cement the coal if seams were workable as this had been omitted in the original work order. The log shows neither where the packer was set, nor where gas was found, merely the statement "dry in all sands." However, this morning a representative of the farmer (a newly elected official of Wetzel County) came in wishing to get permission to save the gas for the farmer. He did not know where the gas had been found but stated they had 240 lbs. of rock pressure. Of course you know the Manufacturers Light and Heat Company will want to pull all the casing, although he did not know how much they wanted to pull.

Since the Well is 3583 feet deep, I made the usual explanation that all coal-protecting strings of casing must be left in the well as long as it is produced which would probably be prohibitive in cost for the farmer. He said there was no coal of commercial value in this locality. I also added that the farmer would be responsible for the plugging of the well after it was exhausted and too that it could not be done unless the coal was valueless and the production found in a sand near the surface - say Salt Sand or Big Dunkard, and in that case the well would have to be plugged from the bottom that that point, first.

Will you please interview Harry Palmer, the farmer, and make the reasons clear to him and find out exactly the value of the coal and depth of the production in the well? Personally I do not believe we should permit the request in this instance.
