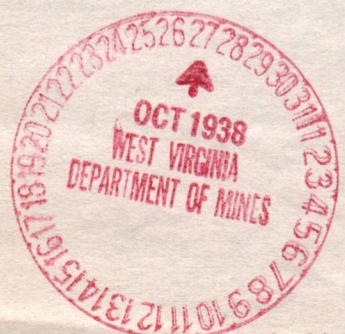

Said coal operators are further notified that forms for use in making such objections will be furnished to them by the Department of Mines promptly on request and that all such objections must set forth as definitely as is reasonably possible the ground or grounds on which such objections are based and indicate the direction and distance the proposed location should be moved to overcome same.

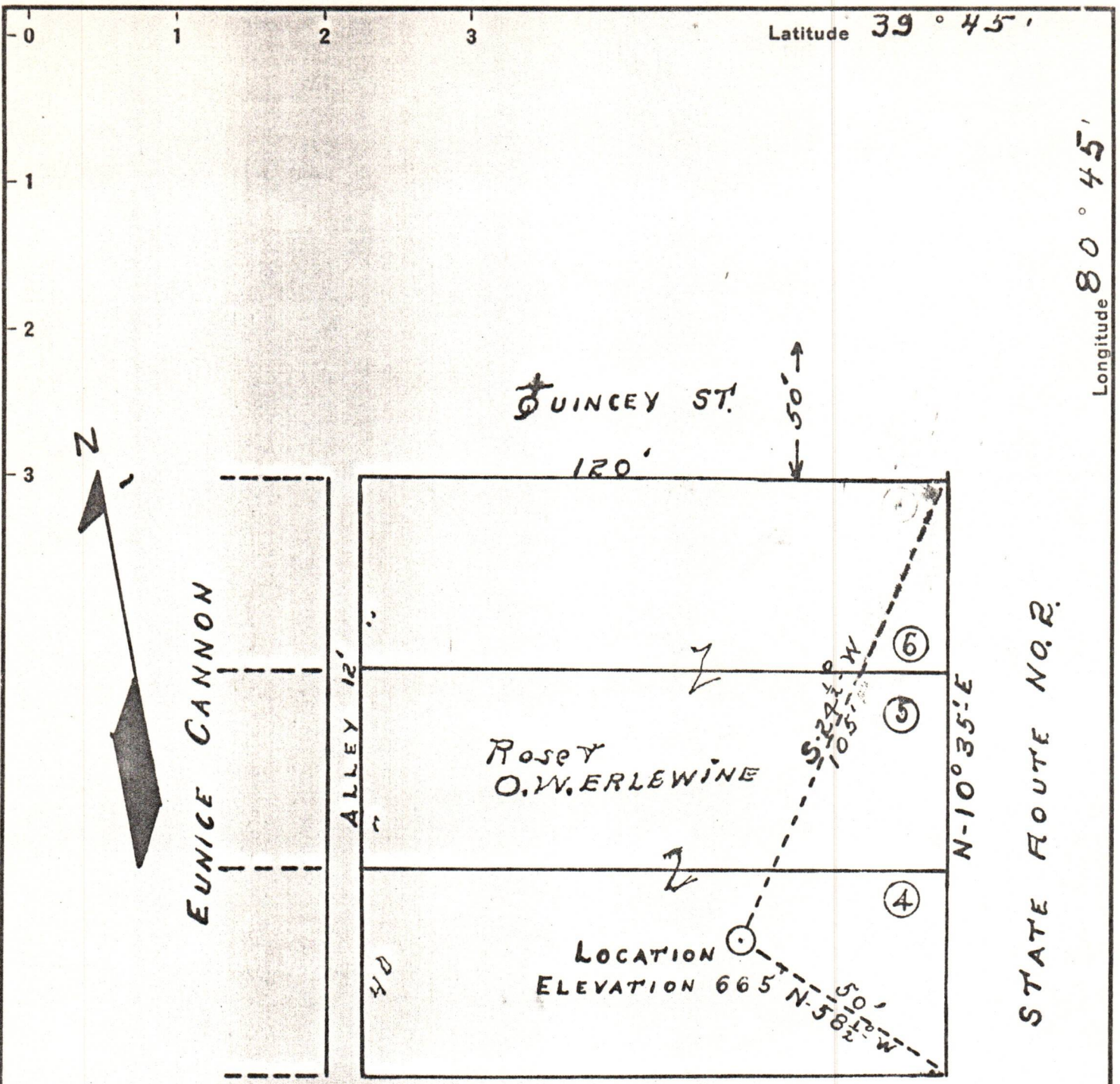
We cannot consider the plugging completed until monuments are erected and reason for this was explained in our letter to you on May 8, 1942, a copy of which is enclosed.
