The above named coal operators or coal owners (if any) are notified that any objections they may desire to make to such proposed location, or which they are required to make by Section 3 of said Code, if the drilling of a well at said proposed location will cause a dangerous condition in or about their respective coal mines, must be received by, or filed with the Department of Mines within ten* days from the receipt of a copy of this notice and accompanying plat by said Department. Said coal operators are further notified that forms for use in making such objections will be furnished to them by the Department of Mines promptly on request and that all such objections must set forth as definitely as is reasonably possible the ground or grounds on which such objections are based and indicate the direction and distance the proposed location should be moved to overcome same.

Gentlemen:

We have your letter of November 9, 1954 in regard to the permit for re-drilling Well No. F-13153 (1-4224) on the James E. Simmons Farm, Proctor District, Wetzel County and will attempt to get your records and ours to coincide.

On August 25, 1953, we received application (OG-1) for the re-drilling of Well No. F-13153 on the James E. Simmons Farm. On this form, it is shown that the lease was made by Otis Simmons et al., dated March 8, 1952 to your Company, recorded March 26, 1952. Our transmittal letter, dated September 4, 1953 advised that permit WET-396 was enclosed for re-drilling this well. If your permit showed WET-393, it was an error in this office but since we do not keep a copy of the permits issued, we are unable to check this item. On December 28, 1953, you advised us that Well No. F-13153 should be changed to Well No. 1-4224 and our records were changed accordingly; However, permit number WET-396 should be shown on your records for both well numbers and, in order to keep your records identical with ours, we are enclosing a duplicate permit which is WET-396.

On February 20, 1954 or approximately six months after permit WET-396 was issued, we received application to re-drill Well No. 1-4224 on the Otis Simmons Farm, Proctor District, Wetzel County. This is the same well number you requested be substituted for F-13153 but the farm name was changed from James E. Simmons to Otis Simmons. Permit WET-392 was issued for this well. WET-329 was in error and seems to have been a transposition of numbers. There may be some question in your mind as to why permit number WET-392 was issued in 1954 and WET-396 in 1953. This came about because your applications filed in 1953 failed to indicate that these wells were acquired and had been drilled under West Virginia Oil and Gas Laws and had been issued permit numbers for the original drilling. When the changes were made, 1953 had elapsed and in order to keep our numbers consecutive, we had to fill in the missing numbers in 1954.

We have your letter of November 9, 1954 in regard to the permit for re-drilling Well No. F-13153 (1-1525) on the James E. Simmons Farm, Proctor District, Wetzel County and will attempt to get your records and maps to coincide.

On August 25, 1953, we received application (00-1) for the re-drilling of Well No. F-13153 on the James E. Simmons Farm, on this farm, it is shown that the lease was made by Otis Simmons of A.L., dated March 8, 1952 to your company, recorded in 28, 1952. Our transmittal letter, dated September 4, 1953 advised that permit WET-396 was enclosed for re-drilling this well. If your permit showed WET-393, it was an error in this office but since we do not keep a copy of the permits issued, we are unable to check this item. On December 28, 1953, you advised us that Well No. F-13153 should be changed to Well No. 1-1525 and our records were changed accordingly. However, permit number WET-396 should be shown on your records for both wells and, in order to keep your records identical with ours, we are enclosing a duplicate permit which is WET-396.

On February 20, 1954 or approximately six months after permit WET-396 was issued, we received application to re-drill well No. 1-1525 on the Otis Simmons Farm, Proctor District, Wetzel County. This is the same well number you requested be associated for F-13153 but the farm name was changed from James E. Simmons to Otis Simmons. Permit WET-392 was issued for this well. WET-392 was in error and seems to have been a transposition of numbers. There may be some question in your mind as to why permit number WET-392 was issued in 1954 and WET-396 in 1953. This came about because your application filed in 1953 failed to indicate that these wells were acquired and had been drilled under West Virginia Oil and Gas laws and had been issued permit numbers for the original drilling. When the changes were made, 1953 had elapsed and in order to keep our numbers consecutive, we had to fill in the missing numbers in 1954.

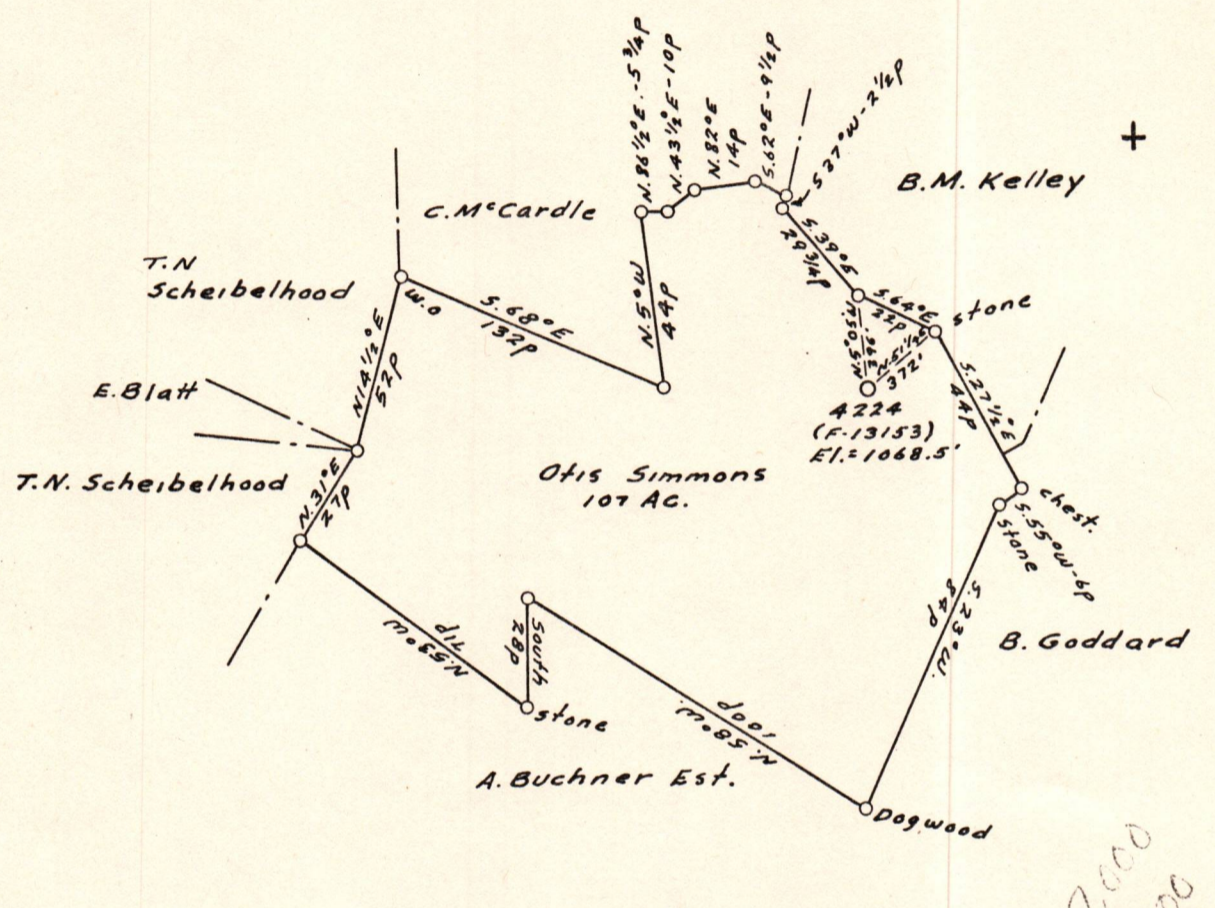
