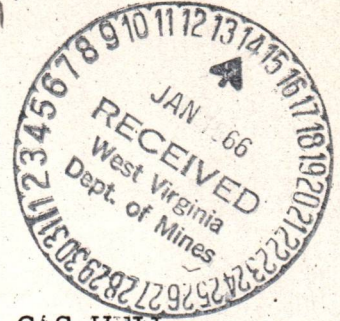

Said coal operators are further notified that forms for use in making such objections will be furnished to them by the Department of Mines promptly on request and that all such objections must set forth as definitely as is reasonably possible the conditions for the protection of life and property under which the well should be fractured to overcome such objections.

PROVIDED FURTHER if the above-named tract of land is being actively mined for coal, the Well Operator shall notify the Coal Operator and the Deputy Director for Oil and Gas 24 hours in advance of the time of day and date actual fracturing of said well shall commence.

In case the well is not fractured within four months from the above date, this Fracturing Permit shall expire and be of no further force or effect.

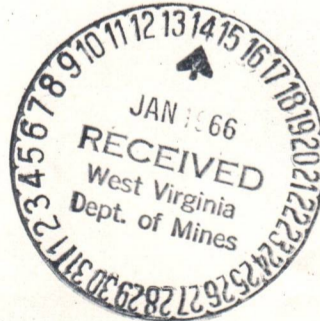

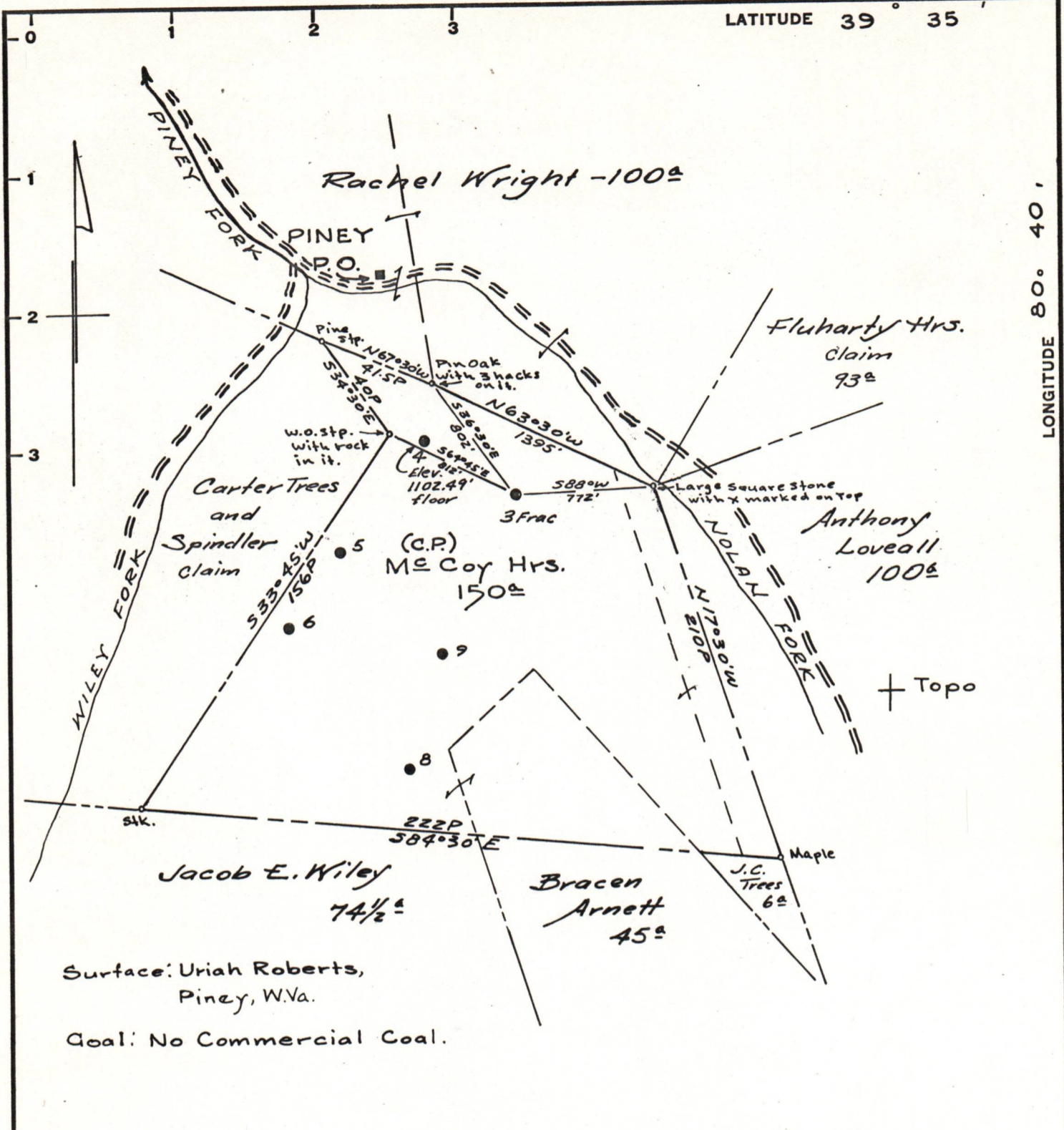
