C O N T R A C T

THIS CONTRACT, made this 21st. day of April 19 81,
between the Oil and Gas Division of the West Virginia Department of Mines,
hereinafter called "Oil and Gas Division" and Steve Duckworth
Davison Rt. Box 88, Gassaway, W.Va. 26624, hereinafter called "CONTRACTOR."

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, the Oil and Gas Division solicited for sealed bids for the
redrilling and plugging of said well and said CONTRACTOR was the low
bidder thereon, and represented that he had adequate equipment in good
working order and fully trained personnel capable of efficiently operating
such equipment with which it desires to plug said well, and therefore, the
said low bid was acceptable to the Oil and Gas Division.

NOW, THEREFORE, for the consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00), cash in
hand paid, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged,
and the further consideration not to exceed the maximum sum of Twenty-one
(\$ 21,900.00)
thousand, Nine hundred & No/100 for redrilling and plugging of said well, to
be paid upon satisfactory completion of the work herein referred to; the
Oil and Gas Division will issue all permits required by law to redrill and
plug the aforesaid gas well. The contractor will furnish at his own cost
and expense all necessary material, labor, tools and equipment, and to com-
plete in a workmanlike and substantial manner said plugging in accordance
with rules and regulations of the Department of Mines, Oil and Gas Division,
and other requirements promulgated under Section 9, Article 4, Chapter 22
of the Code of West Virginia, and further promises and agrees as follows:

1. CONTRACTOR agrees to commence redrilling and plugging of said well
within ten (10) days from date of notice from Oil and Gas Division to pro-
ceed. Well to be redrilled and plugged shall be in accordance with speci-
fications set out in "Work Order," as shown on Form OG-9, Oil and Gas
Division, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

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shall be considered as a condition precedent to the OIL AND GAS DIVISION'S rights hereunder.

The work to be done under this contract shall be performed in accordance with the obligations herein set forth and with the specifications set forth by the Department of Mines - Oil and Gas Division, attachments identified as "Notice of Intention to Plug and Abandon Well" with Permit Number 47-103-1182-P, which is hereby referred to and made a part of this contract, without expense of any nature whatsoever to the State, other than the consideration named in this contract.

CONTRACTOR shall maintain continuous operation in which to complete the work specified herein. It is agreed that time is of the essence in this contract and that in the event of failure to comply with the conditions and provisions herein, CONTRACTOR will reimburse the OIL AND GAS DIVISION in the amount to be determined by the OIL AND GAS DIVISION as sufficient to cover fully any additional demonstrable costs incurred by the OIL AND GAS DIVISION of such failure.

CONTRACTOR agrees that should the work performed under this contract be found not to be acceptable with the specifications and requirements as hereinbefore and hereinafter set forth, that any and all of the work may be rejected by the inspecting officer and all costs occasioned by having an acceptable job performed should be borne by CONTRACTOR.

CONTRACTOR shall comply with the minimum wage rates established by the West Virginia Department of Labor, pursuant to Chapter 21, Article 5-A of the official Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended.

It is understood that CONTRACTOR is not and shall not represent himself as being an agent of the State of West Virginia or of the OIL AND GAS DIVISION.

A copy of the bond given by CONTRACTOR to secure a proper compliance with the terms and provisions of this contract, Certificate of Insurance and Certification of Coverage under the Workmen's Compensation Act of the State of West Virginia, are attached herewith and made a part of this contract.

The CONTRACTOR shall be required, in addition to any other form of insurance or bonds required under the terms of the Contract and specifications, to procure and maintain during the life of the Contract, the following types
