being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Pittsburgh & West Va. Gas Co. well operat and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on 22 day of May, 1934 and that the well was plugged and filled the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged: Total Depth of well 3189 feet.
Clay 3189 to 3145 feet, Cement 3145 to 3133 feet, Clay 3133 to 2980 feet,
Cement 2980 to 2970 feet,
Hole bridged at 2483 feet, Clay 2483 to 2228 feet, Wood plugs 2228 to 2225 feet, Lead Plug 2225 to 2224 feet, Cement 2224 to 2214 feet, Clay 2214 to 2058 feet, Cement 2058 to 2048 feet, Clay 2048 to 1684 feet, Cement 1684 to 1674 feet, Clay 1674 to 1465 feet, Cement 1465 to 1455 feet.

Manner in which coal was plugged: Run 1008 feet of 3" vent tubing on packer at 1008 feet, Cement 1008 to 960 feet, (20 feet above Pittsburgh Coal) Clay 960 to 923 feet, Cement 923 to 869 feet, (20 feet below to 20 feet above Mapleton Coal.) Clay 869 to 583 feet, Cement 583 to 530 feet, (20 feet below to 20 feet above Coal at 530 to 553 feet.) Clay from 530 feet to surface.
