The well is to be plugged with Wood cement and Stone, this is 4-7/8 in hole and there is 95 ft. sand and slate, 30 ft gas sand + 65 ft. slate. Showing of water and oil in sand, at 1195-61' depth, in gas sand, and this sand to be filled. There was no coal found in the hole and there is no coal operators in rail county. This well is in an old abandoned field drilled and pulled and plugged years ago, this well is an lease got by Dr. C.W. Wise of Huntington, W. Va. and others. The original lease is lost. There is no Pittman in this field.

Fill hole with clay from the bottom 1195' to 1145'-20' above gas sand
Set wood plug 1145' to 1145'
Cement 1145' to 1135' sealing hole completely
Remove 6 5/8" casing
Fill with clay 1135' to 941'-20' above Little Dunkard Sand horizon
Set suitable plugs at 941' to seal Dunkard Sand.
Set wood plug at 630'-10' below 8 1/4" casing.
Remove 8 1/4" casing and fill with clay and savings to the surface and erect a marker such as is described in rule 18, 1931 regulations.
