
The undersigned well operator is about to abandon the above described well and will commence the

PROPOSED MANNER OF PLUGGING AND FILLING WELL

(REQUIRED BY RULES AND REGULATIONS)

WORK ORDER

Well to be plugged and filled as follows:

WORK ORDER SUPPLIED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MINES:

- Fill the hole with red clay from the bottom 1333' to 1280'-20' above the Salt Sand.
 - Drive wood plug 1280-1277
 - Continue filling with red clay from 1277' to 80'-20' above the show of gas above the Gas Sand.
 - Drive wood plug 880'-877'
 - Cement plug 877' to 867' sealing the hole completely
 - Continue filling with red clay to bottom of 6 1/4" casing and pull the casing.
 - Fill to surface with red clay
 - Erect a monument such as is described in Rule 18, 1931 Regulations.
- All be done in workman-like manner.

To the Department of Mines,

Gentlemen:
