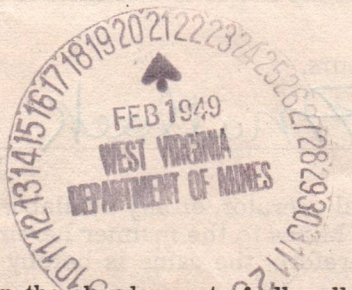

Set bridge at base of Brea sand - 2 sacks neat cement & 5' crushed stone on bridge

Fill up 100 feet with clay substance

Run 10 feet of Cement

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 1608' - 30' below 6-5/8" casing

2 sacks neat cement and 5' crushed stone on bridge - Fill with clay to 1212' Neat Cement 1212 - 1192' - Pull 6-5/8" c.

Set bridge at 940 feet

Fill up 100 feet with clay substance

Run 10 feet of Cement

Pull 8-1/4" casing

Set bridge at ~~565' set~~ 550' - 2 sacks neat cement and 5' crushed stone on bridge - Pull 10" casing

Fill to top with Red mud.

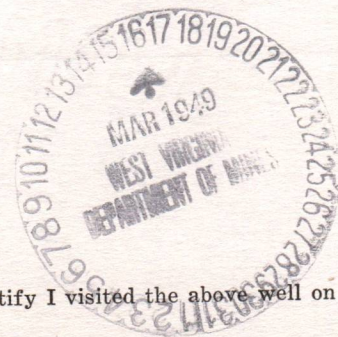

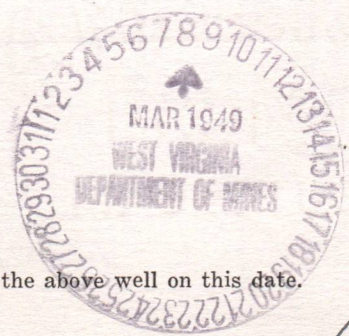

Said coal operators are further notified that forms for use in making such objections will be furnished to them by the Department of Mines promptly on request and that all such objections must set forth as definitely as is reasonably possible the ground or grounds on which such objections are based and indicate the direction and distance the proposed location should be moved to overcome same.

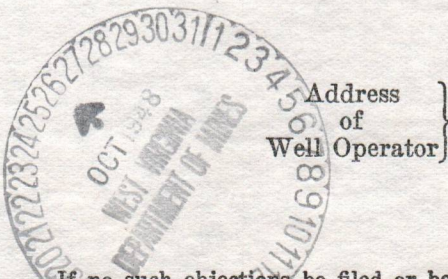

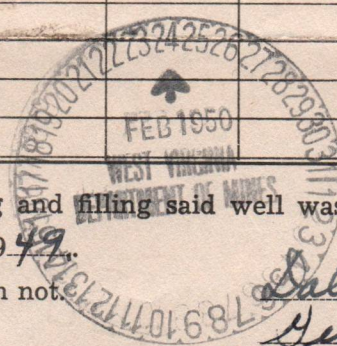

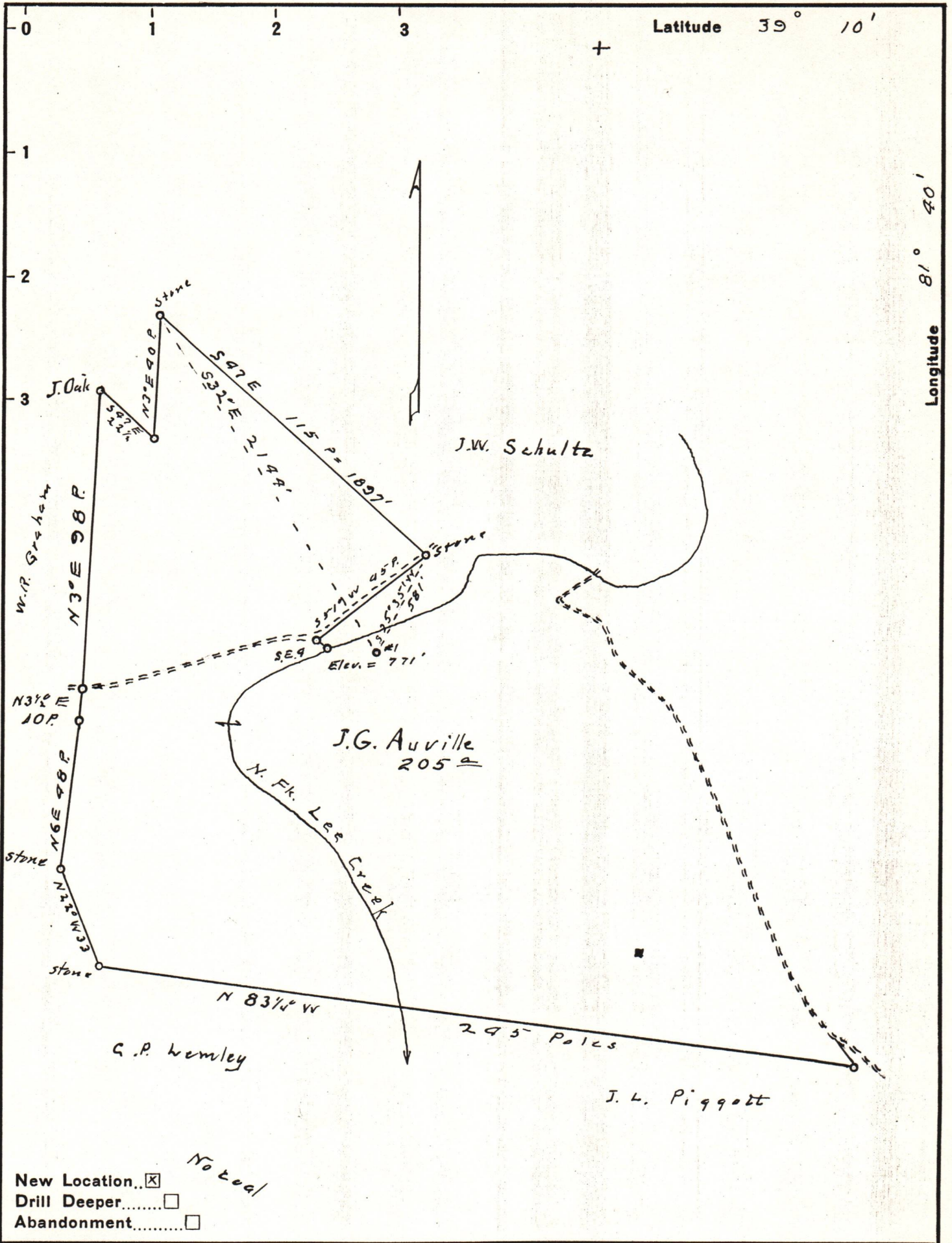
