Failure to abide by all statutory and regulatory provisions governing all duties and operations hereunder may result in suspension or revocation of this permit and, in addition, may result in civil and/or criminal penalties being imposed upon the operators.

### PERMIT CONDITIONS

West Virginia Code §22-6-11 allows the Office of Oil and Gas to place specific conditions upon this permit. Permit conditions have the same effect as law. Failure to adhere to the specified permit conditions may result in enforcement action.

#### CONDITIONS

- 1. In the event of an accident or explosion causing loss of life or serious personal injury in or about the well or while working on the well, the well operator or its contractor shall give notice, stating the particulars of the accident or explosion, to the oil and gas inspector and the Chief within twenty-four (24) hours.
- 2. Well work activities shall not constitute a hazard to the safety of persons.
- 3. Notification shall be given by the operator to the Oil and Gas Inspector at least 24 hours prior to the construction of roads, locations and/or pits for any permitted work. In addition, the well operator shall notify the same inspector 24 hours before any actual well work is commenced and prior to running and cementing casing.

The work order for the manner of plugging this well is as follows:

- Notify inspector specialist, Allen Flowers @ (304) 552-8308.
   Email address is <u>Allen.D.Flowers@wv.gov</u>, <u>Notification is required 24 hrs prior to commencing plugging operations.</u>
- 2. Move in and rig up to existing 8-1/4 inch casing.
- 3. TIH pull rods, tubing and packer if found.
- TIH check TD @ or below 1930'. If TD cannot be reached begin cleaning out hole to approved depth/TD by inspector.
- 5. Once TD has be reached and approved by inspector a bond log will be ran inside the 5-3/16" casing to determine cement bond location and free points. Any casing found with out cement in the annulus that cannot be retrieved must be perforated at all required locations.
- TIH to TD with tubing, spot 6% gel followed by cement from TD' to 1585'. TOH, WOC tag top of plug. Add cement if needed.
- 7. TIH with tubing, spot 6 % gel from 1585' to 1200', followed by cement plug From 1200' to 1000'. TOH, WOC tag top of plug. Add cement if needed.
- 8. TIH with with tubing, spot 6% gel from 1000' to 600', followed by cement Plug from 600' to 400'. TOH, WOC tag top of plug. Add cement if needed.
- 9. TIH to 400', attempt to cut and pull the 8-1/4" casing. Run bond log if Required. If casing cannot be removed perforate at all required locations.
- 10. TIH with tubing, spot gel from 400' to 300' followed by cement plug from 300' to surface.
- 11. Rig down and install monument, reclaim site.
  - NOTE.. Any casing found in the well with out cement In the annulus that Cannot be retrieved must be perforated and cemented at all saltwater, Freshwater, coal, gas, casing shoe and elevation points.
- 12. Class L cement will be used as a replacement for Class A cement during Supply chain interruptions.

#### Well detail:

The Office of Oil and Gas does have a well record for the subject well (47-015-00027). The record shows well TD at 1930'. 18' of 10" casing was used for the conductor. 479' of 8-1/4" casing and 1764' of 5-3/16" casing. Cemented casing locations are unknown. The record shows salt water at 1183', fresh water at 545', gas at 1635' and coal at 438'. Packer and tubing unknown. Well site elevation is 1044'. The well was shot from 1901' to 1919'.

#### Site-based considerations:

The well site is flat and covered in grass. There is no storage tank located at the well site. The well is currently shut in. The well is leaking gas and oil around the well head. There is production equipment located at the well, all equipment will be removed. OOG will contact locate 811 to mark all sub surface utilities.

Records held by the Office of Oil and Gas (OOG) indicate that you are the landowner of a parcel located along the Elk River Procious, WV further identified on tax forms as Parcel ID: 08-06-0010-0011-0000. Our records additionally show that well API Numbers 47-015-00027,47-015-00614,47-015-00641,47-015-00646 and 47-015-00658 are located on that property. Based on the abandoned well inspections dated August 21, 2023 (see enclosed), these wells are considered a potential hazard or imminent danger, a possible pollutant to the surface or underground, or is wasting natural resources (leaking) and must be properly plugged or cleaned out and re-plugged.

Pursuant to W. Va. Code § 22-6-29, and under the direction and supervision of West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection, a contractor for the State of West Virginia will enter onto the property, properly plug the above named well at no cost to you. Further, the state will remove all associated materials from the well location and reclaim, seed, and mulch the well location and well road accesses used, to state specifications.

Please sign and return the enclosed form, WW-4D, affirming that you have no objection to the State of West Virginia having a responsible contractor enter upon or traverse your property for the purpose of plugging this well. #### REPORT OF THE OFFICE

In response to industry requests, the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection, Office of Oil and Gas has reviewed the proposed use of American Petroleum Institute (API) Class L cement to be used in place of API Class A cement for well plugging.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On July 28, 2022, Diversified Gas & Oil Co. (DGO) submitted a variance request from Legislative Rule 35CSR4 for the use of API Class L cement in place of API Class A cement, relating to the plugging of conventional wells.
- Laboratory analysis submitted by DGO on July 28, 2022, indicates API Class L cement is comparable to API Class A cement and thereby satisfies the requirements of the West Virginia Code.
- 3. Contemporaneously, the Chief of the Office of Oil and Gas also chose to consider a variance to Legislative Rule 35CSR8 Section 20.1., for the use of API Class L cement in place of API Class A cement, relating to the plugging of horizontal wells.

Promoting a healthy environment.

 On August 18, 2022, the Office of Oil and Gas provided public notice of acceptance of public comments on the variance consideration. During the 20-day public comment period, no comments were received.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Pursuant to Article 6 and Article 6A, Chapter 22 of the Code of West Virginia, the Office of Oil and Gas has jurisdiction over the subject matter, and the persons interested therein, and jurisdiction to promulgate the hereinafter prescribed Order.

Pursuant to Legislative Rule 35CSR4, Section 18 and Legislative Rule 35CSR8, Section 14, the Chief of the Office of Oil and Gas may grant a variance from any requirement of these rules.

#### ORDER

It is ordered that the Class L cement product approved and monogramed by API is approved for use in place of API Class A cement for well plugging subject to the provisions of Legislative Rule 35CSR4 and Legislative Rule 35CSR8.

#### Site Preparation:

200 Ft of silt fence will be installed around the well site to isolate the disturbed area. The area around the well 50' x 100' shall be cleared of all brush, trees leveled and smoothed. All trees and brushes can be stacked and left on location. The service road will need to be widened and stoned to accommodate plugging equipment. The service road shall be ditched with E&S controls. All production equipment shall be dismantled and removed from the well site. Stone or tie mats will be placed around the well head to stabilize the rig. A minimum 24" cellar will be installed around the well head.

#### Site Reclamation:

All production equipment shall be removed and disposed of. The silt fence shall be removed. All tie mats and/or stone shall be removed from the well site. The cellar shall be removed from around the well head. All disturbed areas will be smoothed, seeded and mulched per DEP code. A well monument will be install at the well head, minimum 6" diameter and 42" above final grade.

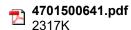

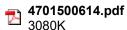
