December, 1924 - 1290 ft. $5\text{-}3/16$ " casing put in well. Larkin packer put in well.

February, 1928 - New steel derrick. Fine outfit.

Iron belt and engine house.

20 h. p. Bessemer engine.

Needs new rig timbers soon.
