Completed, July, 1915.

No casing record, but 6-5/8" is set on Big Lime at 1350'.

The 8 1/4" is pulled out, but 10" casing is in the well. There is always from 40' to 60' of 10" casing left in the wells along the river as there is quicksand there.

December, 1925 - new steel derrick.

No shot record, but would be shot from 1507-1517'; thickness of pay sand.

Iron derrick.

Iron belt and engine house.

Good condition on Leslie siding river (?)
