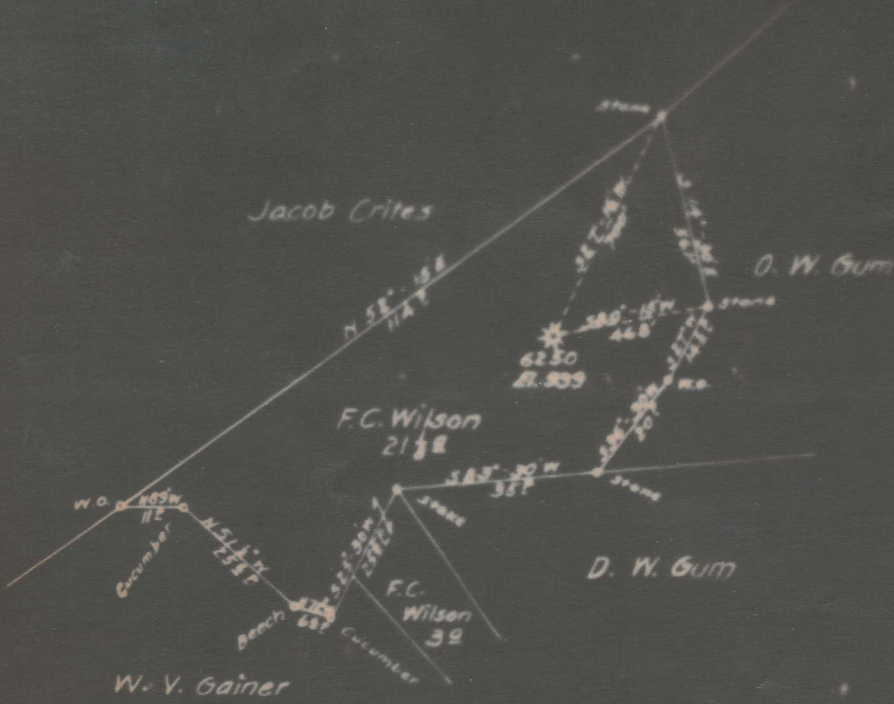

A. J. Rife and James L. Barker being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Hope Natural Gas Company, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 15th day of February, 1938, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Handwritten notes: 4330, 2-17-38

Manner in which sand was plugged: Filled hole with mud and clay from total depth (1830) to 1720'-20 feet above 31' lime and run 8" wood plug and two sacks cement, then continued filling with mud and clay to 1634'-20' above the top of Laxon Sand, drove 8" wood plug and run two sacks cement; filled solid to 1610'-30' below Salt Sand, made permanent plug, and filled solid with mud and clay to 1501'-20' above Second Salt Sand and ran 8" wood plug and two sacks cement, then filled solid to 1390' and ran 8" wood wedge plug and 8" lead plug to shut off stray gas, then filled solid to 1250'-20' above the First Sand and ran two sacks cement.

Bridged hole at 990'-30' below Gas Sand and filled solid with mud and clay to 780' and Manner in which coal was plugged: then drove 6" wood plug; pulled 8" casing, except two bottom joints pulled off and left in hole. After pulling 8" casing, hole caved in to depth of about 400', then we filled hole solid to 167'-10' below where 10" casing had been placed, found no 10" casing in hole, then filled hole solid to the surface.

Description of monument: A square monument made of concrete, 12" x 12" x 5', set in concrete base 30" x 30" x 3", monument extends 20" above the surface.
