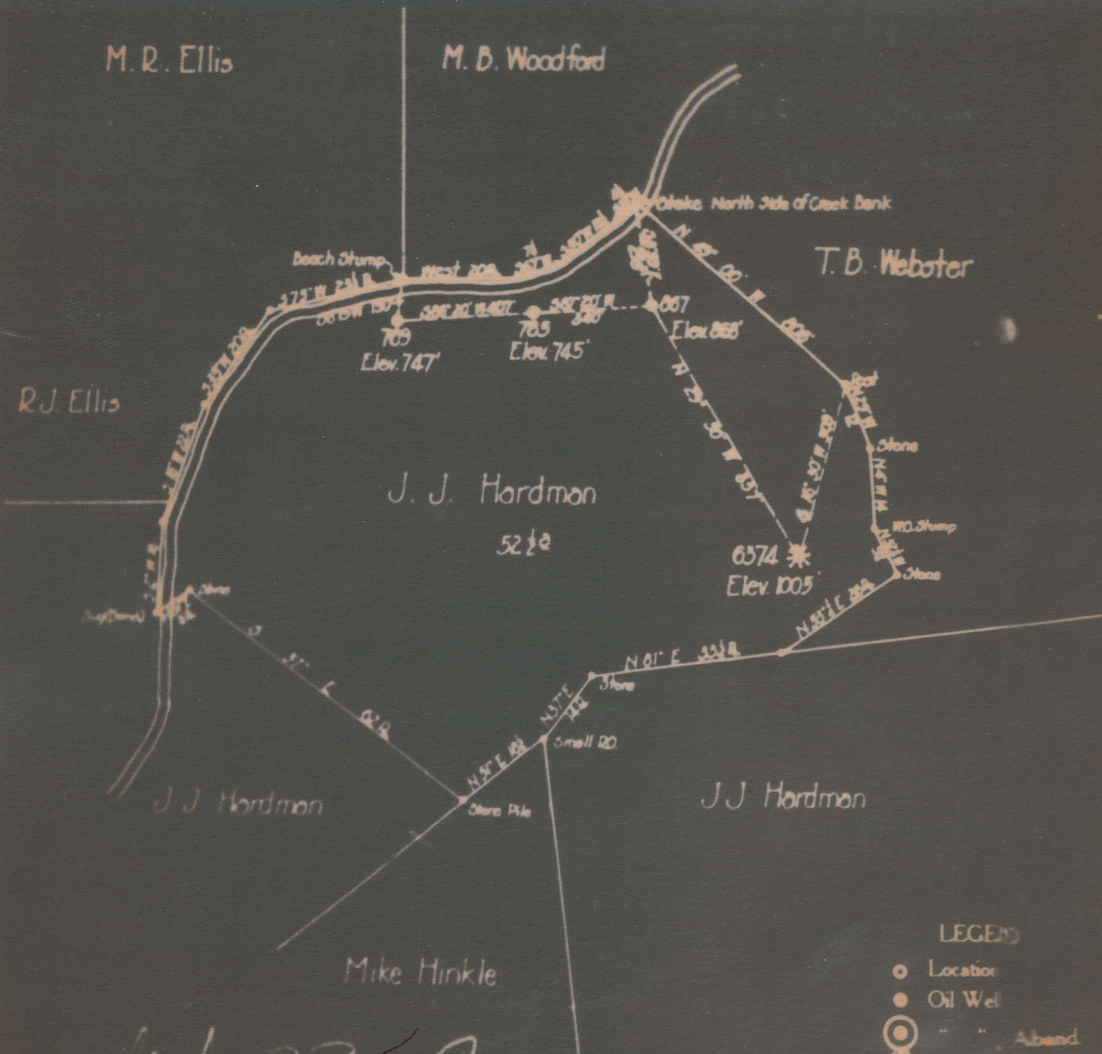


Plan of WELLS No 6574 & H.C. 709-705-007

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging

and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Hope Natural Gas Company, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the

25th day of March, 1932, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged: Filled hole with clay from total depth of 2035' to 1940' - 20' above Big Injun Sand, and drove 5-3/16" Wood and 5-3/16" Lead plugs. Pulled 6-5/16" Casing and continued filling with clay and sand pumpings 1880' and drove 6-5/8" Wood plug and ran 200-lbs. cement. Tried to pull 6-5/8" casing and found it necessary to rip same ten times, last ripped @ 1809' - being 51' above 1st. Salt Sand, Left 601' 1" 6-5/8" Casing in hole. Hole caved and filled solid to 600'. Drove 10" Wood plug and set 200-lbs cement @ 600'. Filled solid with clay and sand pumpings to 188" and drove 10" Wood plug. Pulled 10" casing and filled solid with clay to surface.
