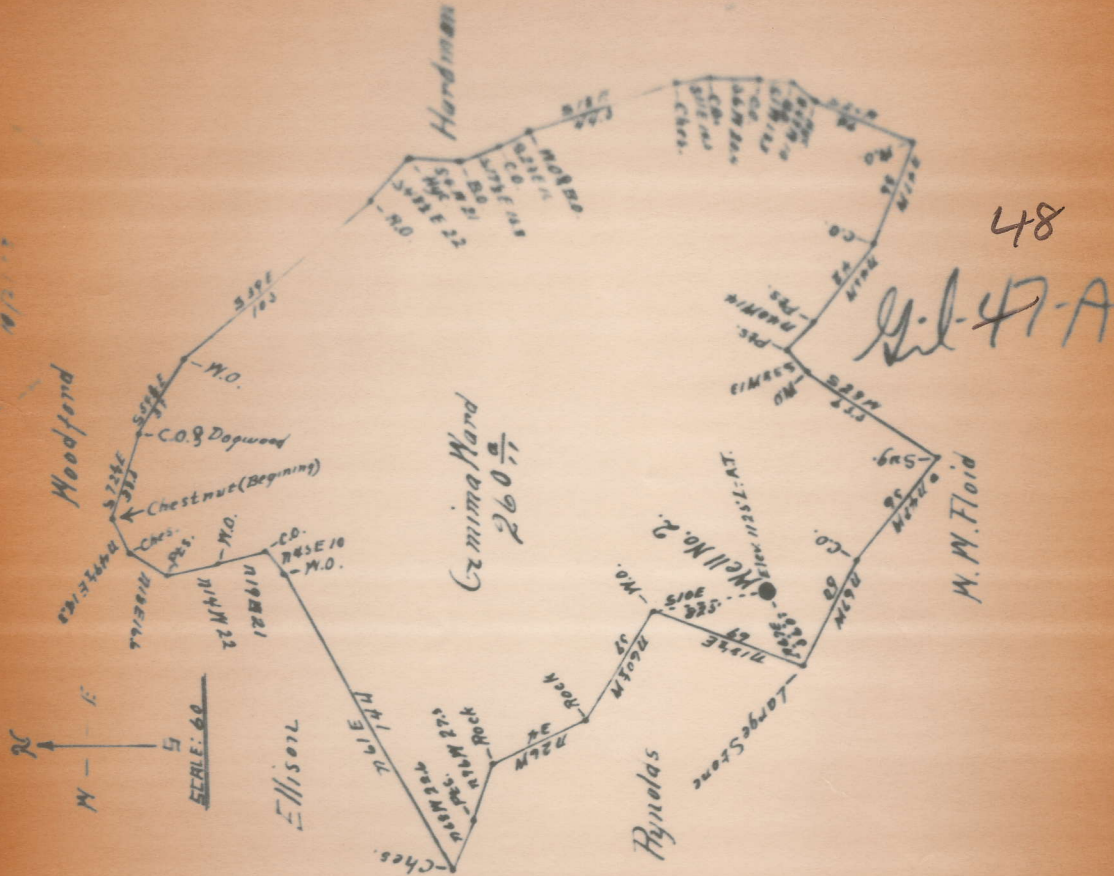

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable considerations, cash in hand paid to Hope Construction and Refining Company, a Delaware corporation, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, said Hope Construction and Refining Company does hereby grant, bargain, sell, and assign and set over unto E. F. Daubenspeck and Jesse Mason, all of its right, title and interest in and to said Company's well No.950 located and drilled on said certain 260 acre tract of land situate in DeKalb District, Gilmer County, West Virginia, on the waters of Sinking Creek, leased for oil and gas purposes by Jemima Ward to C. S. Connolly by agreement of lease bearing date the 30th day of March, 1908, and recorded in the office of the Clerk of the County Court of Gilmer County, West Virginia, in Book No.66, at page 171.

Together with all of the tubing, casing, 2" line pipe, pumping outfit, 20 H. P. Engine, tanks, and other property constituting the complete equipment of said well.

The said Hope Construction and Refining Company, for said consideration, also grants unto the said E. F.
